Speaker Profiles

Professor Stephen Monaghan

Public Health Director, Cardiff and Consultant in Public Health Medicine, Public Health Wales

Stephen Monaghan is currently the Public Health Director for Cardiff and a consultant in public health medicine with Public Health Wales. He is also a member of the Vision Forum of the Cardiff Local Service Board and a Senior Associate at the Nuffield Trust in London.

He is an alumnus of Imperial College London, Cardiff University and Leicester University and is dual accredited as a public health physician and a general practitioner. He holds Membership of the Royal College of General Practitioners, the Diploma in Epidemiology and Fellowship of the Faculty of Public Health. He is also the elected Welsh Member on the Faculty of Public Health's Board and Executive Committee in London and chairs the Faculty in Wales Committee.

He co-authored a book for the Nuffield Trust on Welsh Devolution, Health and Europe and authored an Atlas on Health Inequalities in Wales. He also co-wrote the first draft of what became the Government's *Better Health Better Wales* Green Paper which set the strategic direction for public health in Wales.

He was a Harkness Fellow in Healthcare Policy in the United States of America during 2004-2005 and was based with RAND Health - part of the world's first and largest public policy think tank, where he studied incentives for healthcare quality. Dr Monaghan is an Honorary Professor with the University of Wales and co-ordinates and delivers the Health and Health Policy module of Cardiff University's Masters in Public Health degree (MPH).
