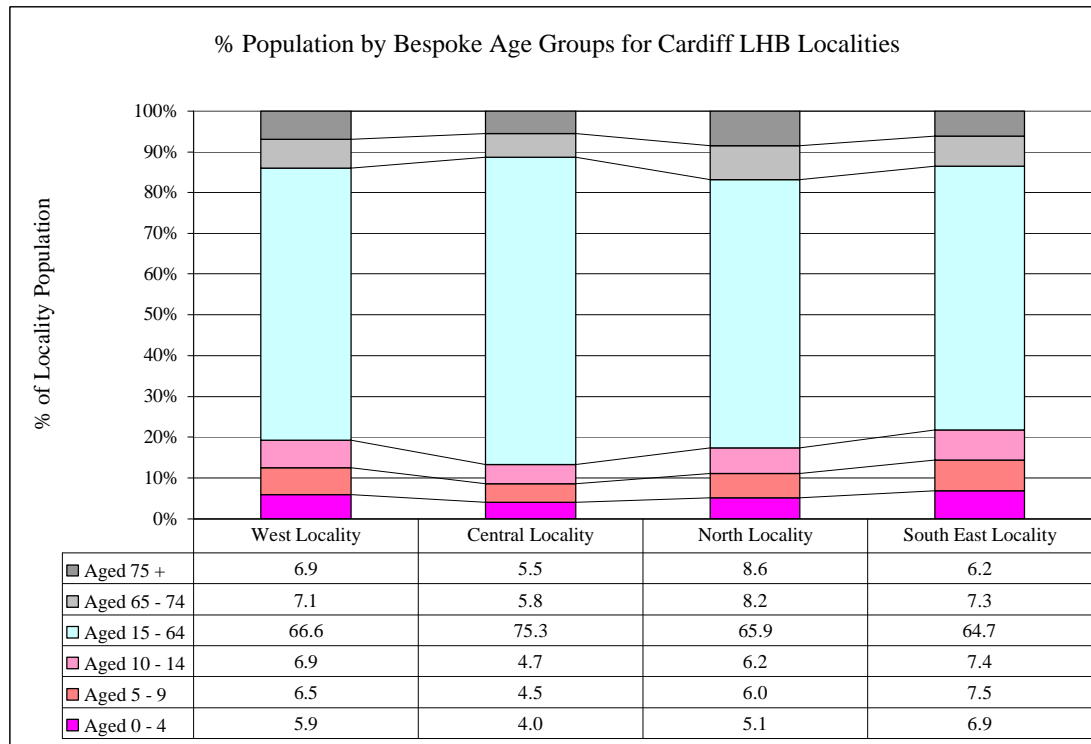


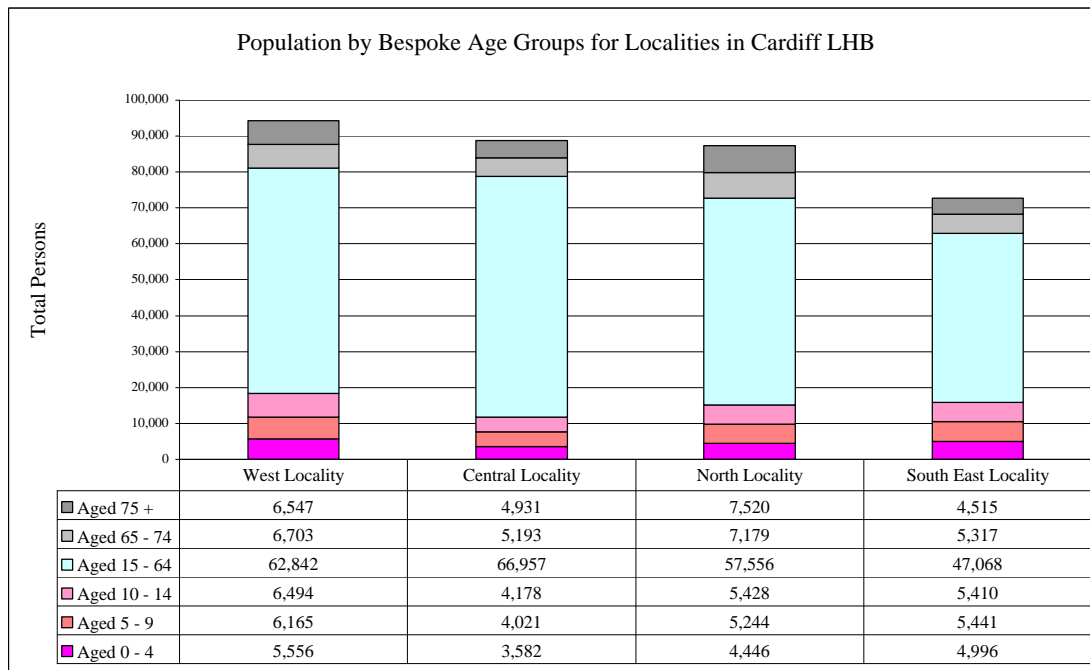
5.1.7 Current Population Distribution by Locality Area and Electoral Division

Child And Elderly Populations

Children aged under 15 and adults aged 65 and over represent the highest dependency ratios amongst the population for health care services (See: A Dictionary of Epidemiology – Fourth Edition edited by John M Last – Oxford University Press 2001).



The North (16.8%) and West (14.0%) localities have the highest proportion of population aged 65 and over. The South East (21.8%) and West (19.3%) have the highest proportion of residents aged 0 to 14. The Central locality has the lowest proportions of elderly and child populations of any of the four LHB Locality Areas due to the high proportion of students resident in the area.



The West Locality has the highest number of child residents at over 18,000, conversely the Central Locality has just 11,800. The North (15,120) has only 700 fewer child residents than the South East (15,850).

The North (14,700) has the highest number of elderly residents followed by the West (13,250). The South East has the fewest elderly residents (9,830), Central contains a slightly higher number at 10,120.

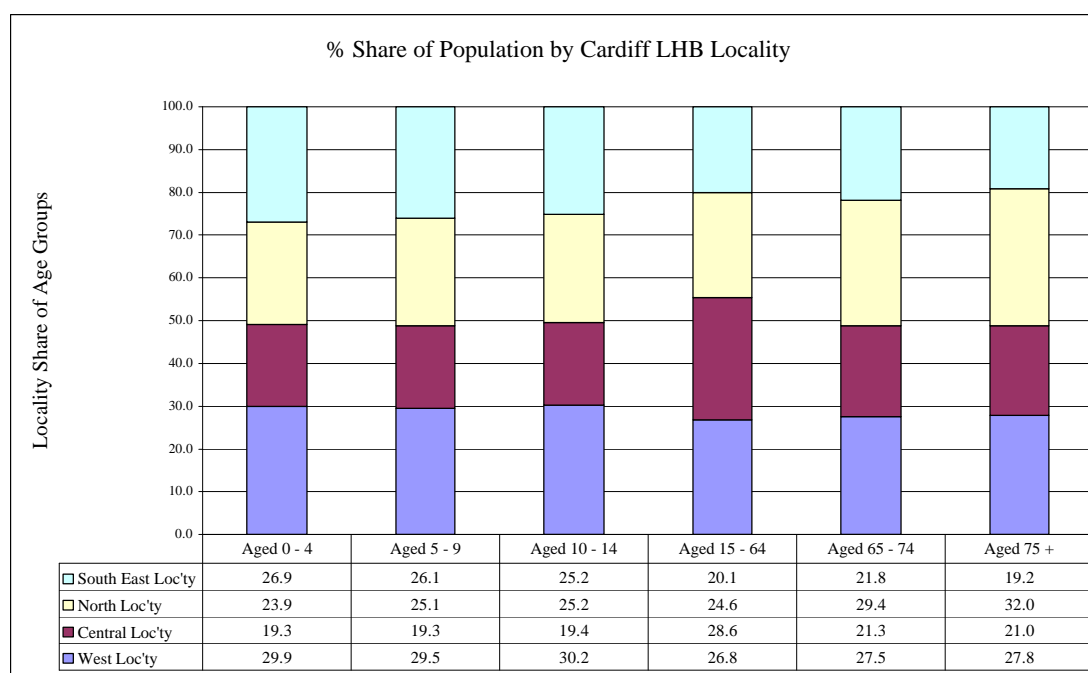
Further analysis of population age structures can be used to produce Population Dependency Ratio's. A population dependency ratio is the sum of population aged 0 to 14 and 65 + divided by the population aged 15 to 64. The higher the ratio the greater the dependency.

The South East locality has the highest dependency ratio (0.55) of Cardiff's four locality areas. However if Gabalfa was located in Central rather than the North, the North would have the highest ratio due largely to the high numbers of residents aged 65 plus and the large number of residents aged 0 to 14 in Pontprennau / Old St Mellons and Llanishen in particular.

The West locality is home to the greatest proportion of Cardiff's child population aged 0 –14.

The Central locality is home to the smallest number of Cardiff's child population.

The North Locality is home to the largest number of residents aged 65 – 74, closely followed by the West locality. A similar rank of population appears for those aged 75 plus, but the concentration in the North is even greater for this eldest age group with almost a third of Cardiff's total resident in the North locality.

The South East has a higher proportion of both younger age-groups and those aged 65-74 than Cardiff as a whole. The Central locality has a lower proportion of both children and the elderly than Cardiff as a whole.

In which Locality do the Highest Proportion of Cardiff's Children and Elderly Live?

Almost a third of Cardiff's children live in the South East Locality, compared to only 20% in Cardiff Central – the highest and lowest proportions respectively among Cardiff's four localities.

The North Locality contains over thirty percent of the elderly in Cardiff, the greatest proportion, the South East Locality and the Central Locality each contain around 21%.

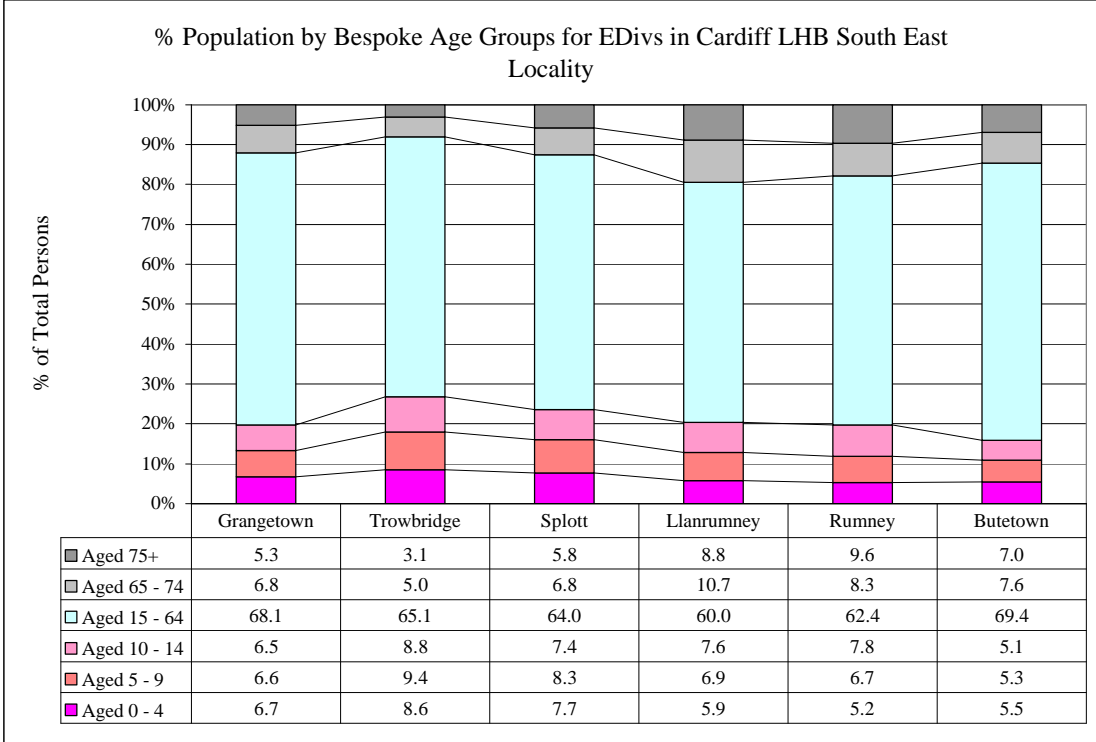

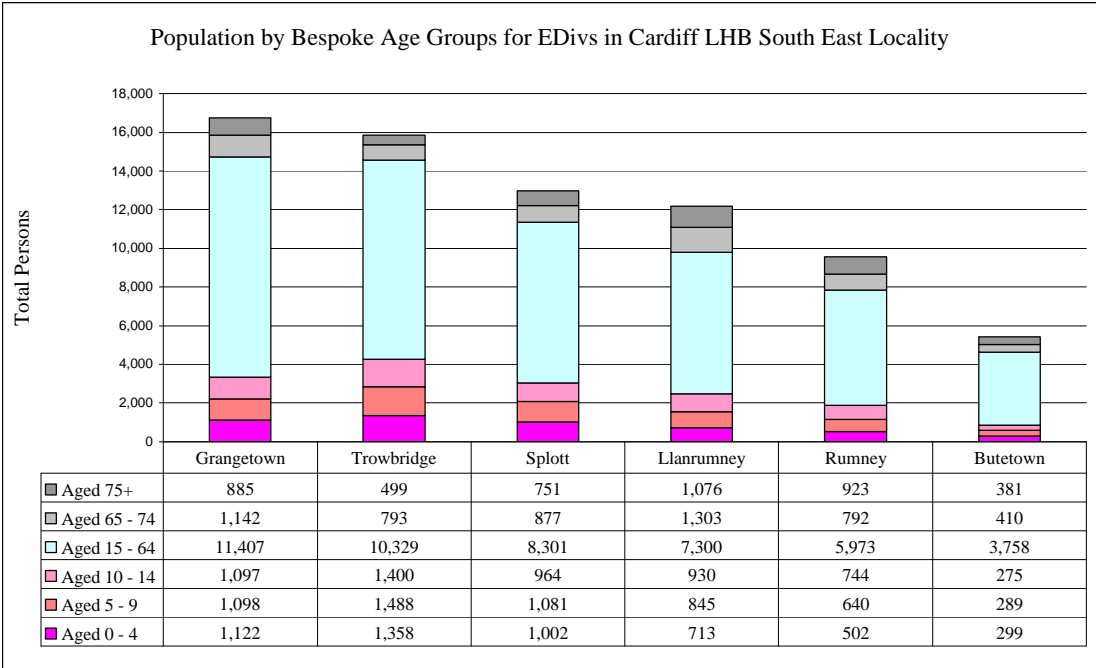

Which South East Locality EDivs have the Highest Proportion of Children & the Elderly?

Splott and Trowbridge contain a higher proportion of residents aged 0-14 than any other EDiv in the South East locality. Butetown contains the lowest relative proportion of residents in this age cohort.



Llanrumney has the highest proportion of population aged 65 and over (19.5%), followed by neighbouring Rumney (17.9%). Trowbridge has the smallest proportion of population aged 65 and over.



Trowbridge contains the highest number of children at approximately 4,250 or 20.4% of the South East total number. Llanrumney contains the highest number of elderly residents with some 2,400 aged 65 and over compared with approximately 2,200 in Grangetown, despite the later's significantly higher population total.

The table below clearly shows that the South East Locality has a higher dependency (0.55) than the LHB average (0.46). In the South East Llanrumney has the highest dependency ratio at 0.67 of any EDiv within the Locality.

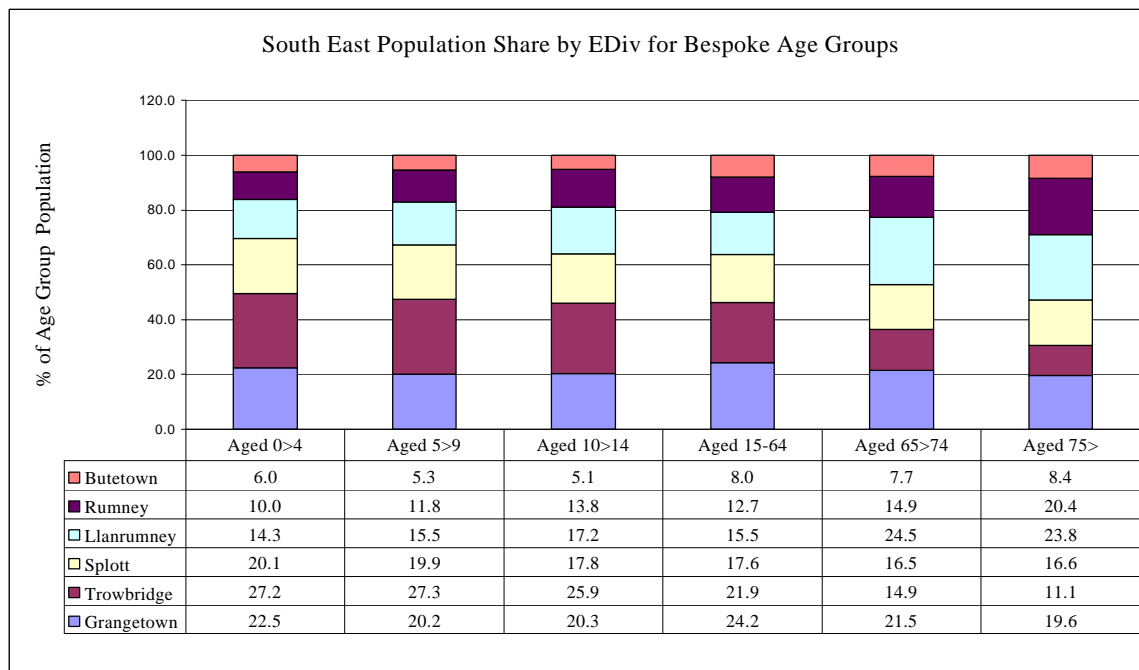

Llanrumney is home to the highest proportion of the South East's elderly population aged 65-74 and 75 and over.

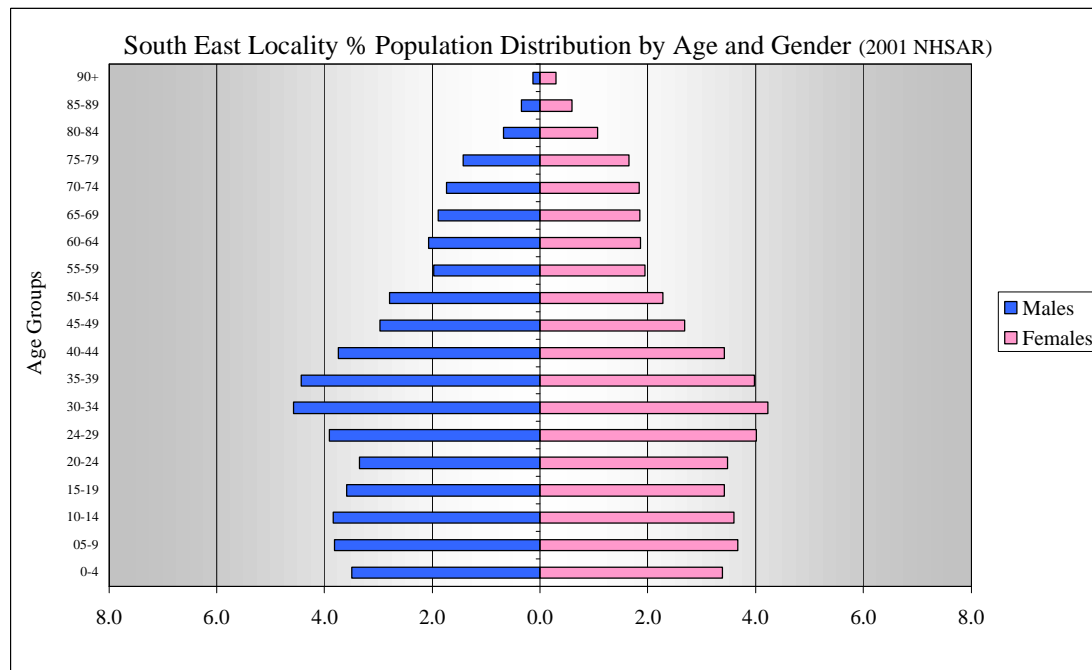

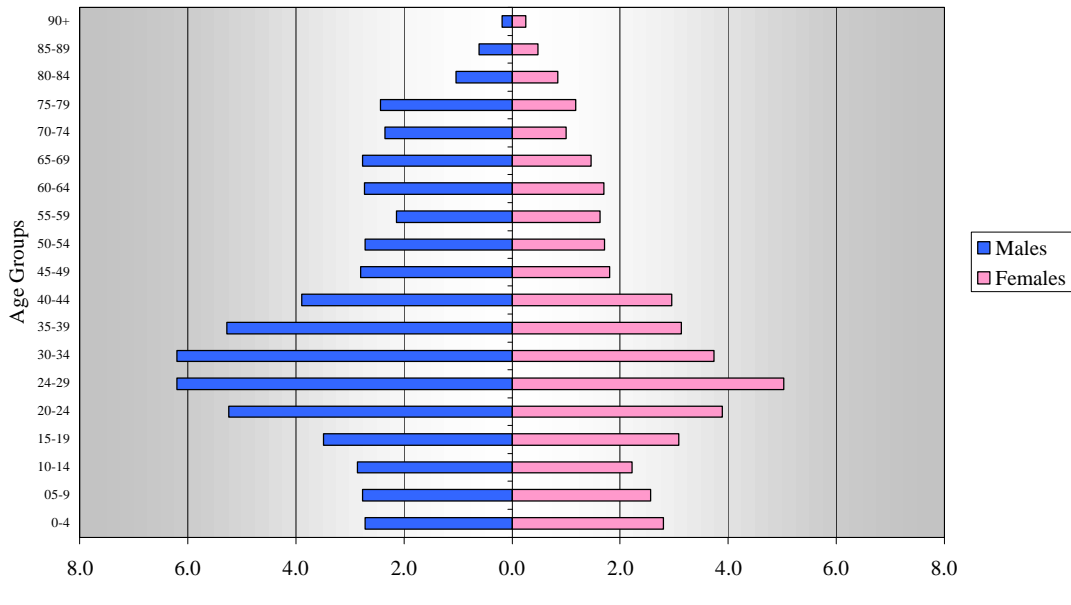
Among the South East's 6 EDivs Trowbridge contains over one quarter of its children followed by Grangetown with between 20 and 23 %. Llanrumney contains almost 25% of the South East's elderly population while Butetown only contains between 7 and 9% of residents in the South East aged 65 and over.

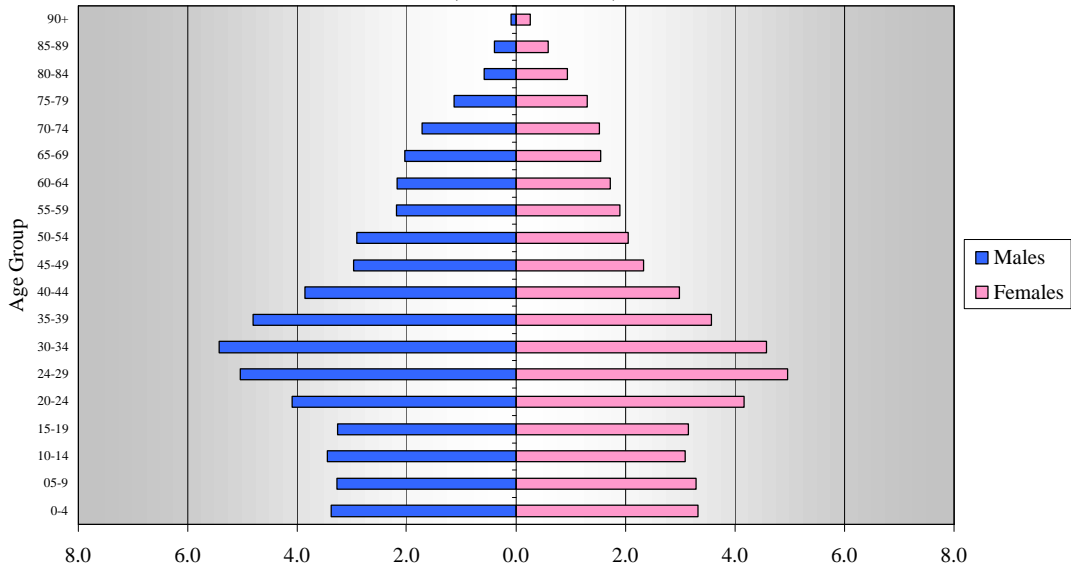

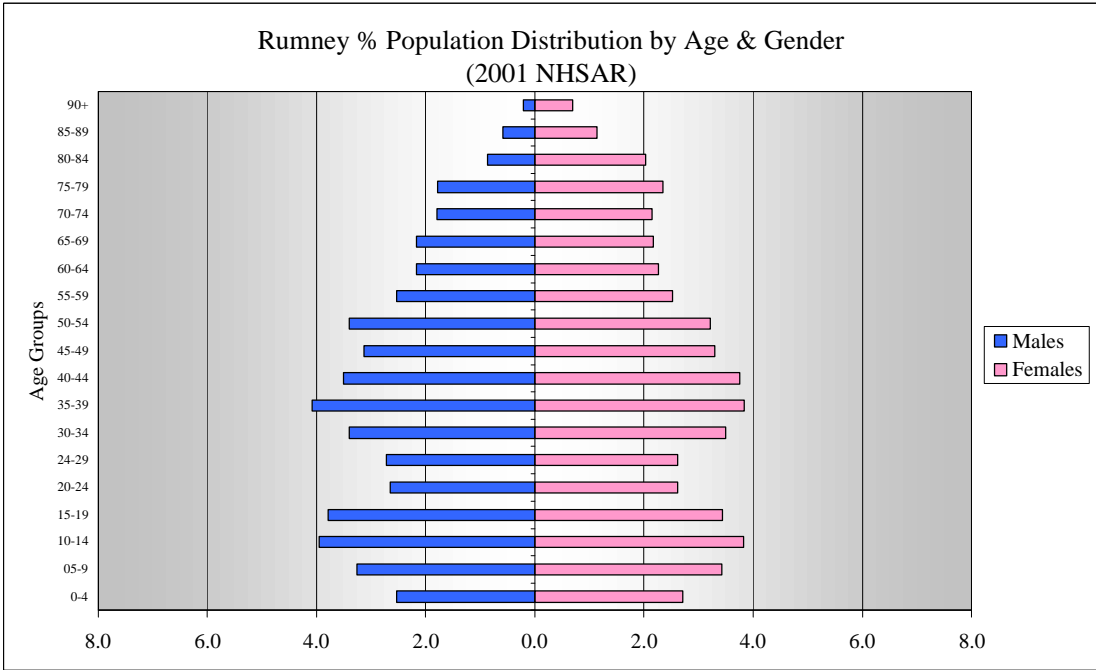
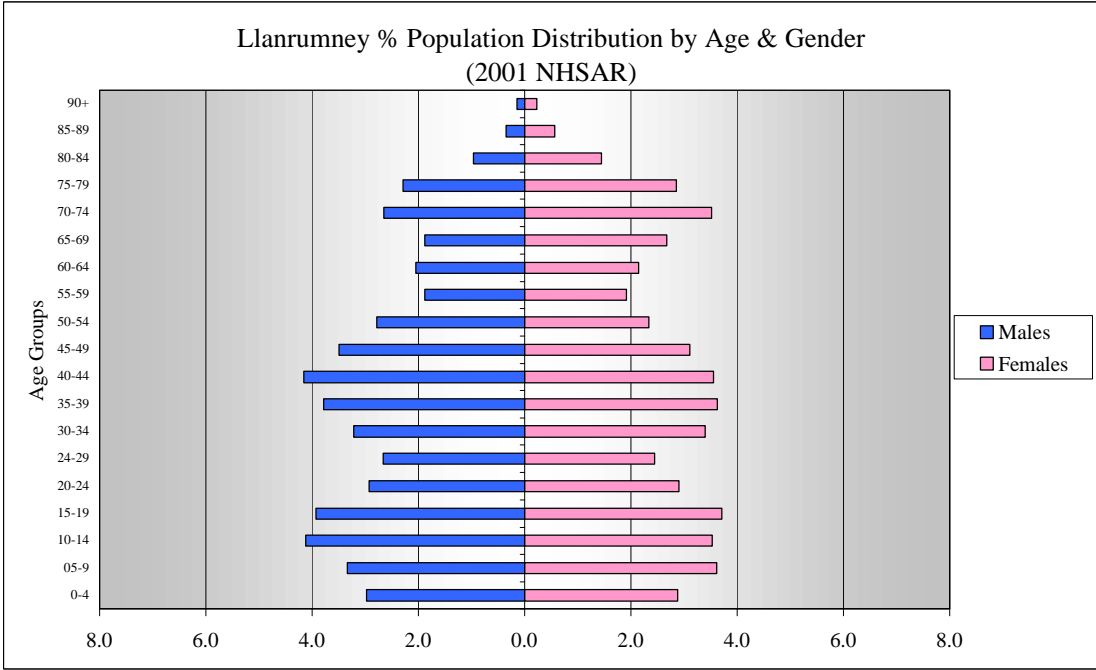


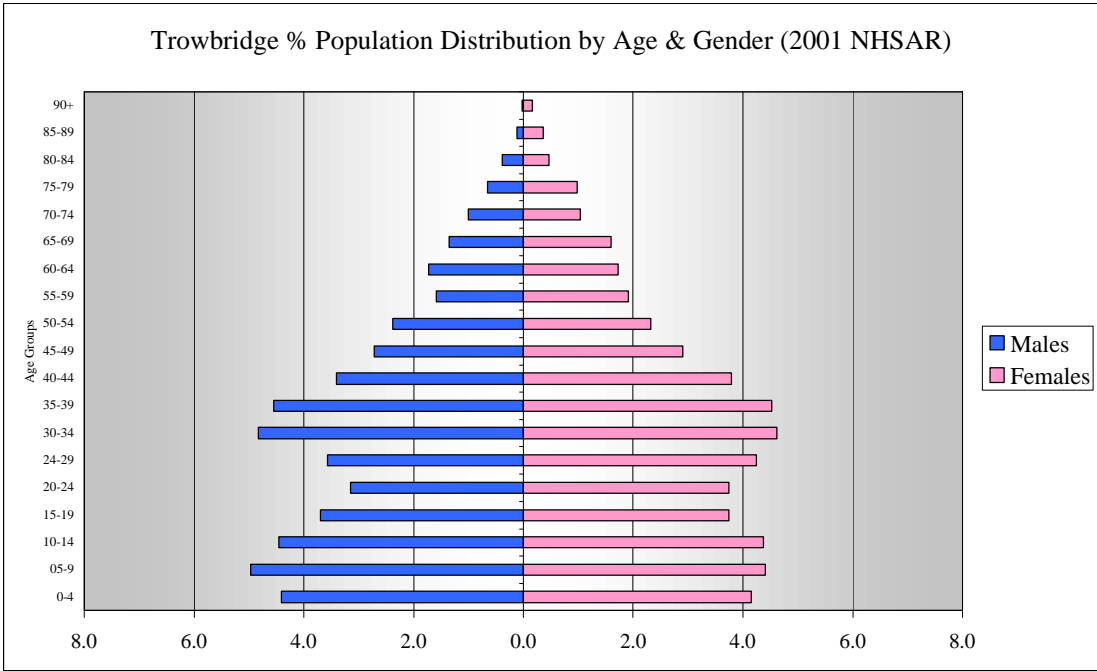
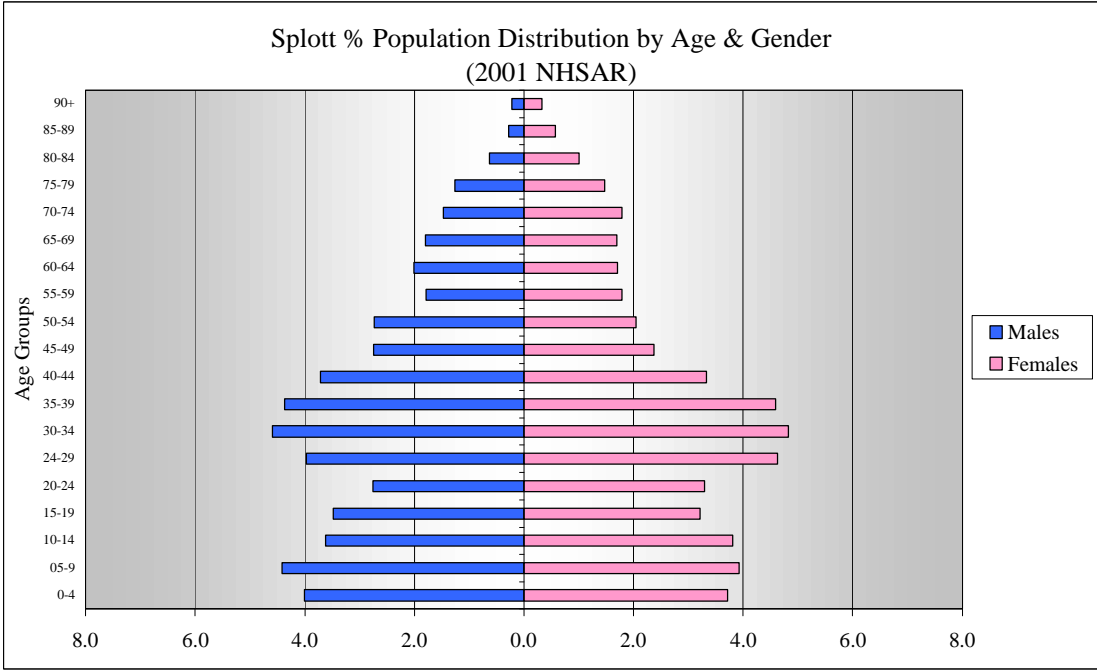
Butetown % Population Distribution by Age & Gender (2001 NHSAR)



Grangetown % Population Distribution by Age & Gender (2001 NHSAR)

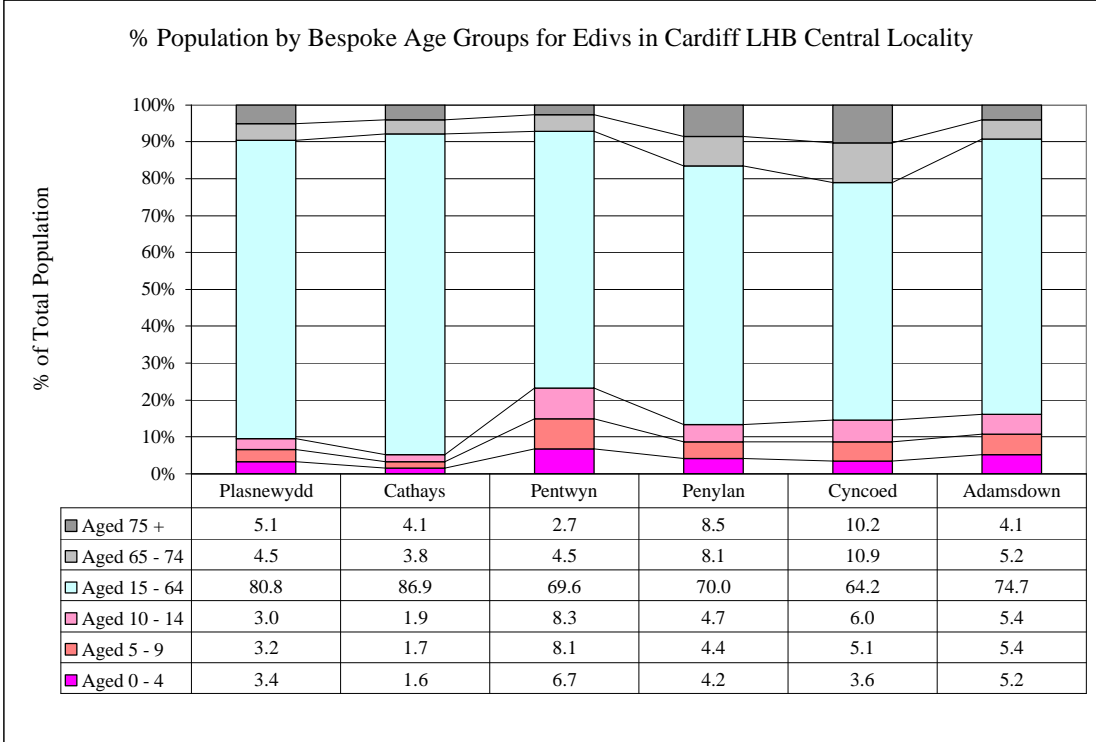






Which Central Locality EDivs have the Highest Proportion of Children & the Elderly?

The Central locality has the lowest proportion of children and elderly as already noted. Within its five EDivs Pentwyn is the only one with a proportion of children higher than the Cardiff average. See Figure below



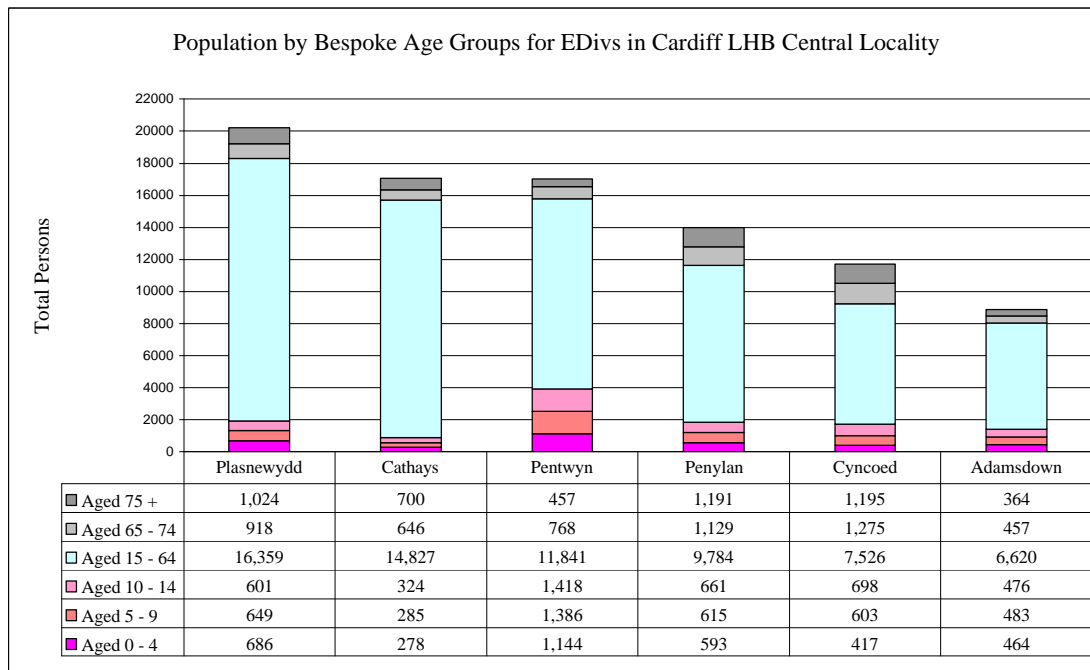
Cathays has the lowest proportion of residents aged 04, 5-9 and 10-14 of any EDiv not just in the Central locality, but in the whole of Cardiff.

Cyncoed has the highest proportion of elderly residents of any EDiv in the Central locality.

Pentwyn (7.2%) and Cathays (7.9%) have the lowest proportions of elderly residents within the Central locality.

Pentwyn has the highest number of resident children aged 0-14, totalling some 3,950. Meanwhile Cathays has the lowest number of children totalling some 1,350.

Cyncoed has the highest number of elderly residents (2,470), while Penylan with a higher overall population has nearly as many elderly residents totalling some 2,320.



Only Adamsdown has a lower number of elderly residents (820) than Pentwyn (1,225).

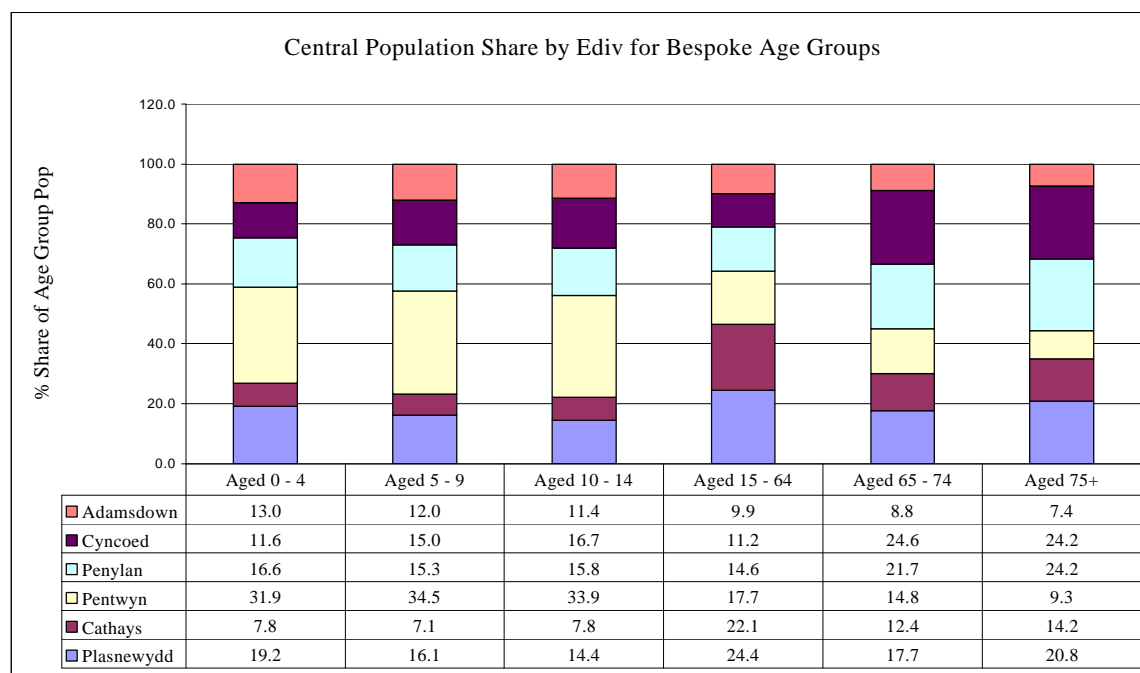
The Population Dependency Ratios for each EDiv in the Central Locality are presented in the table below. Cyncoed has the highest ratio in the Central Locality with Cathays and Plasnewydd showing the lowest ratios, largely due to the high proportion of full time students aged 18 and over resident in these EDivs.

Which EDivs Have the Highest Proportion of Central Cardiff's Children and Elderly Residents?



Pentwyn is home to the greatest proportion of Central's population aged 0 – 4 (31.9%), 5 – 9 (34.5%) and 10 – 14 (33.9%) despite being only the second largest EDiv in terms of total population.

Cathays has the smallest proportion of Central's child populations at between 7 and 8%.

Cyncoed and Penylan have the highest proportions of Central's elderly populations with almost half the Locality's residents aged 75 and over between them.

Adamsdown contains the smallest proportion of Central's elderly residents largely due to its much smaller total population.

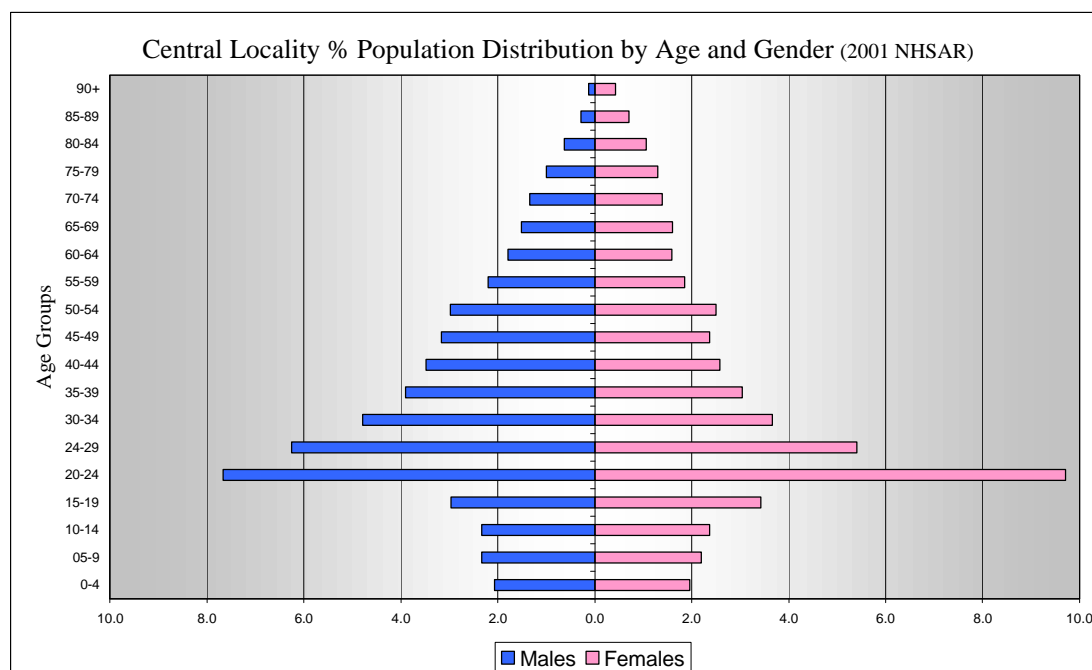

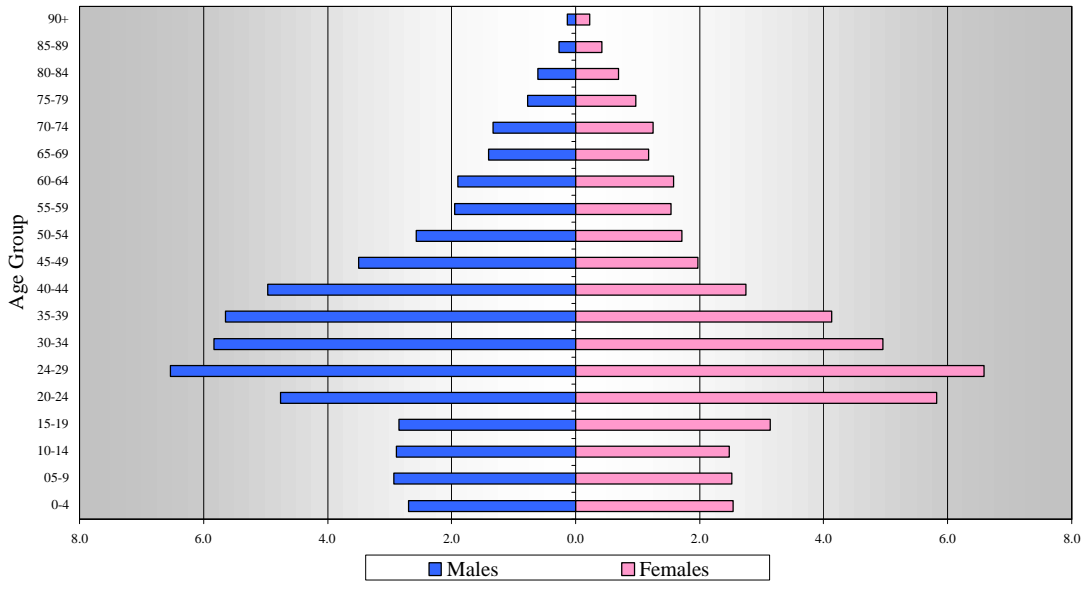
Central has the smallest proportion of children of any of the four localities – as previously noted and among the Central’s 6 EDivs Pentwyn strikingly contains almost a third of all its children, followed by Plasnewydd with between 15 and 20%. Cathays (the city centre) contains only 7% of Central’s children.

Central has the smallest proportion of elderly of any of the four localities – as previously noted and among the Central’s 6 EDivs almost half of the elderly live in Cycoed and Penylan. Adamsdown contains only just over 8% of Central Cardiff’s (already lower proportion) of elderly.

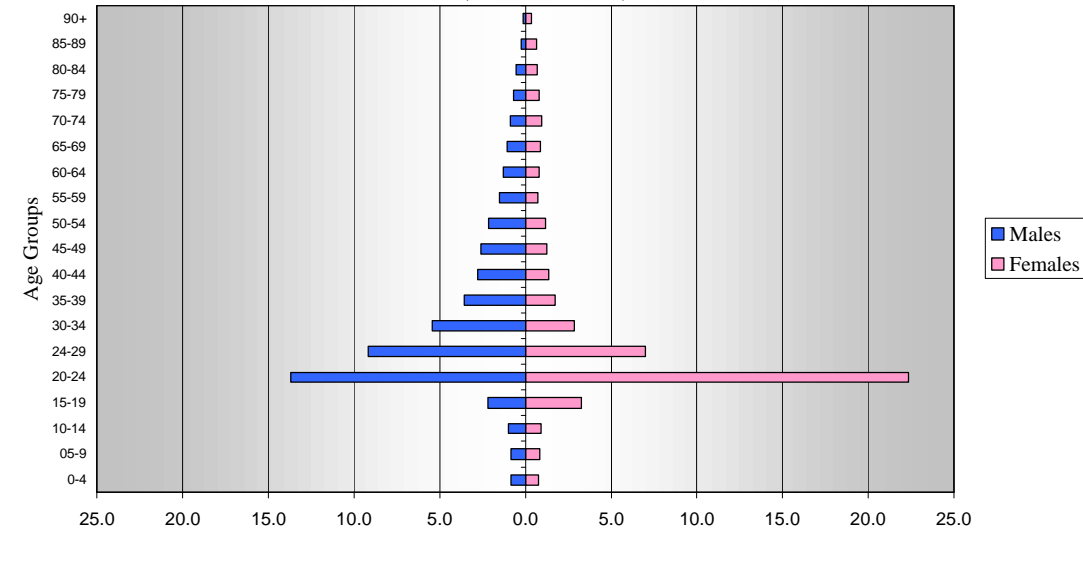
Central Locality and Constituent Electoral Divisions Detailed % Population Distributions by Age and Gender



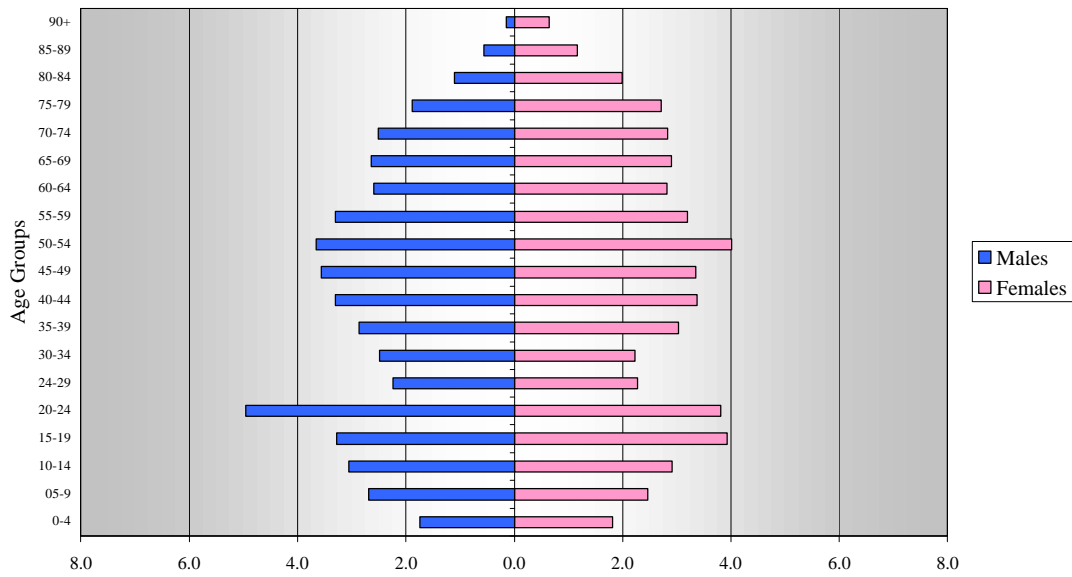
Adamsdown % Population Distribution by Age & Gender (2001 NHSAR)



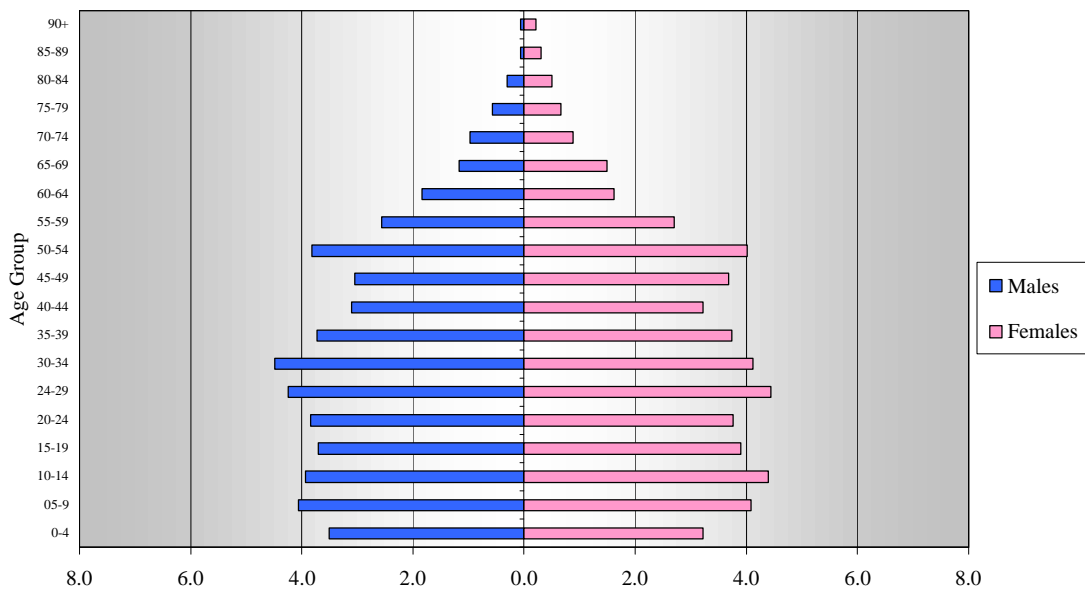
Cathays Population Distribution by Age & Gender (2001 NHSAR)

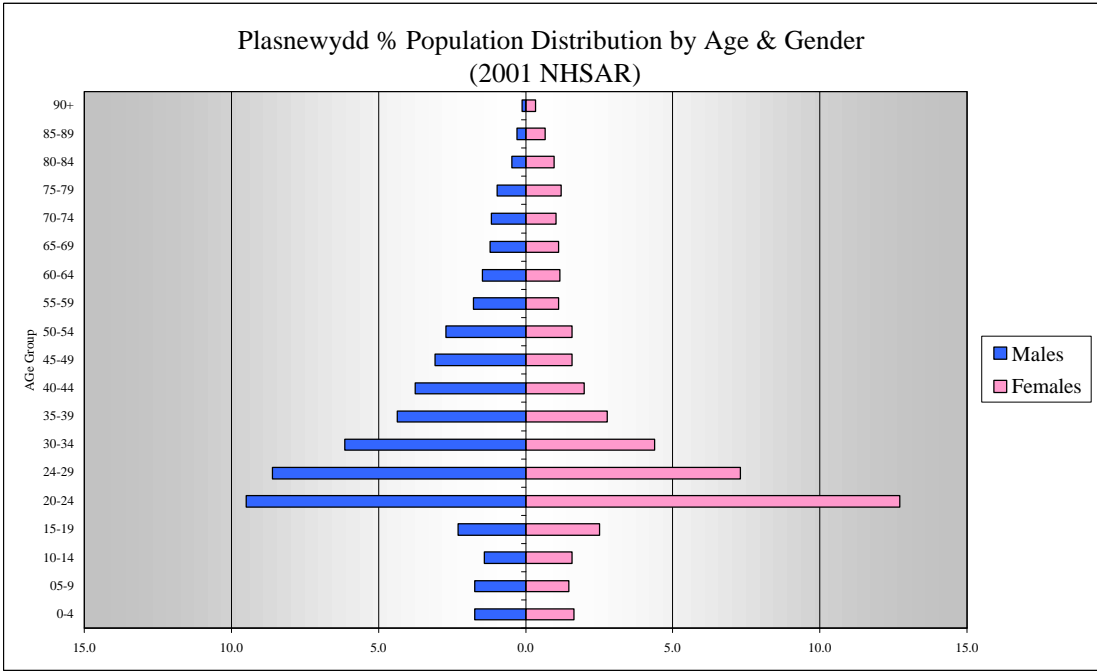
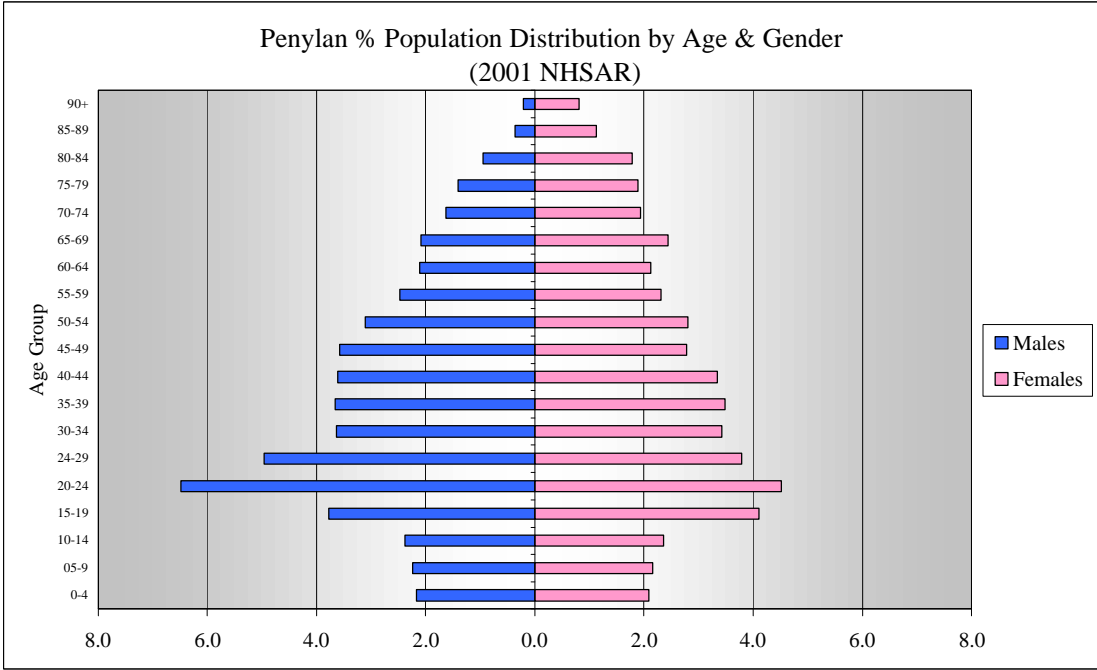


Cyncoed % Population Distribution by Age & Gender (2001 NHSAR)



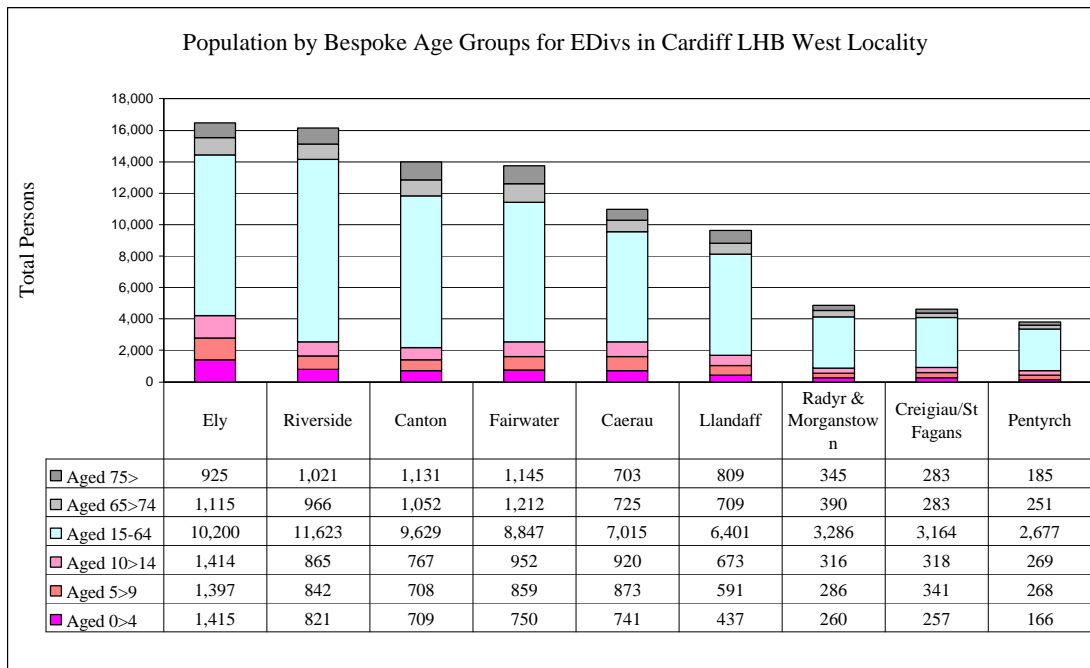
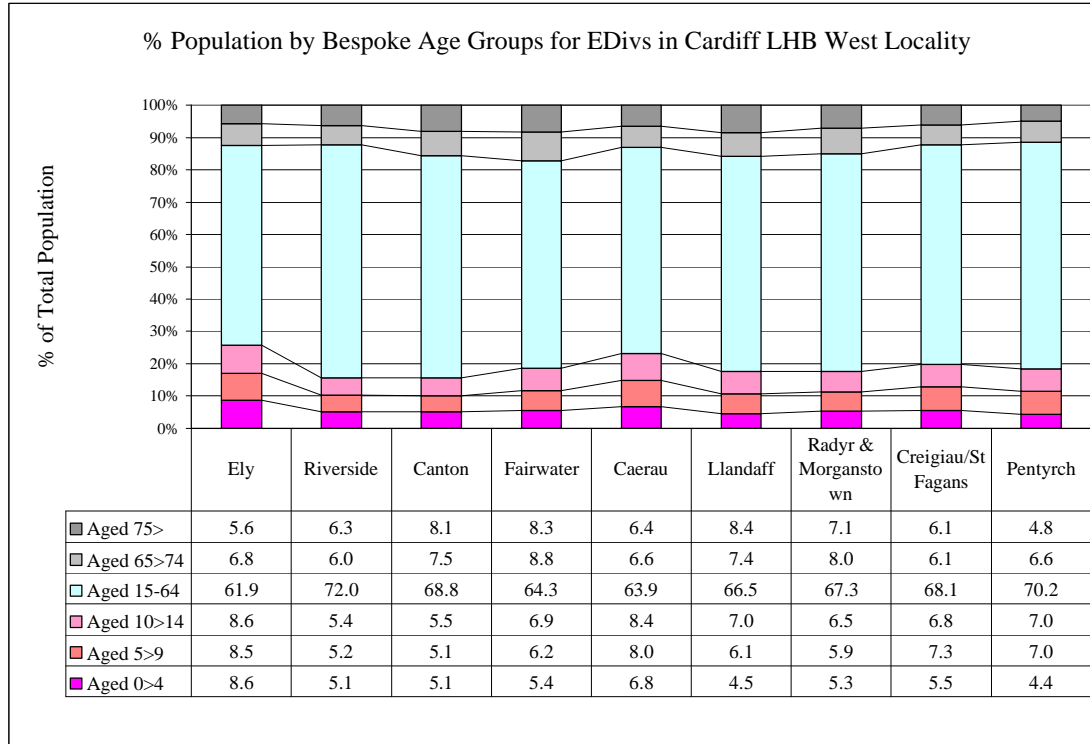

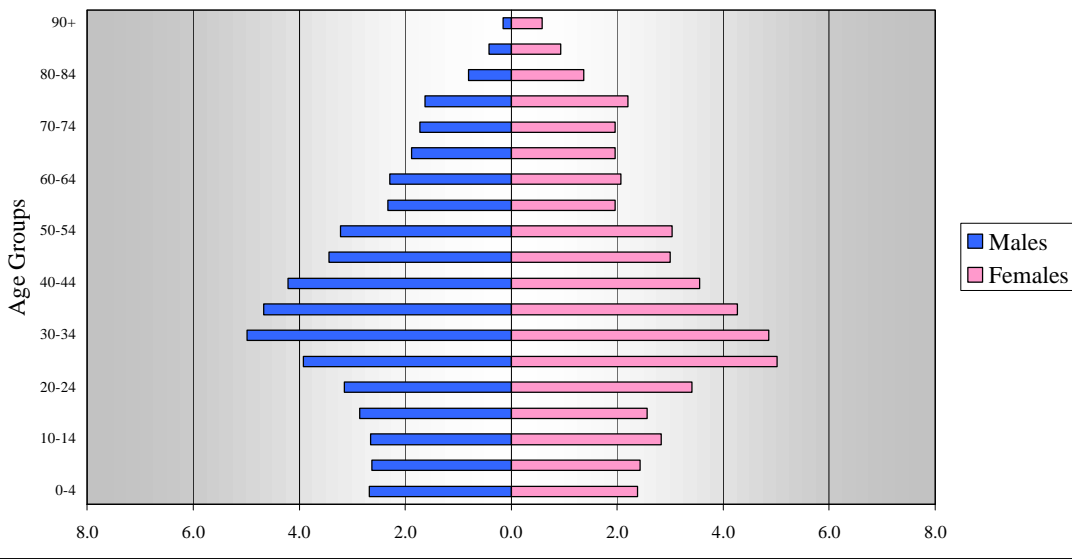
West Locality and Constituent Electoral Divisions Detailed % Population Distributions by Age and Gender



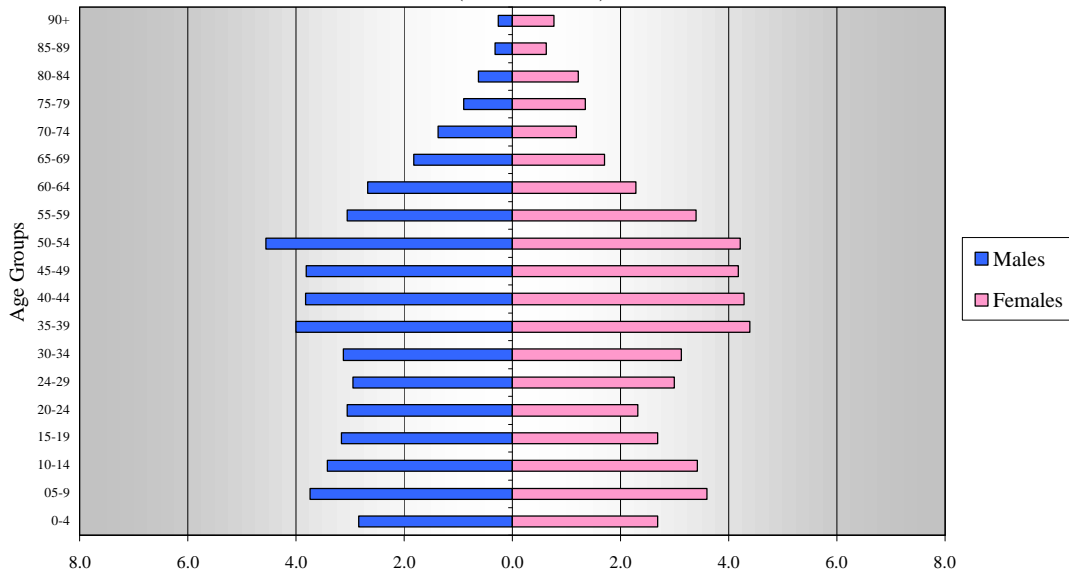
Caerau % Population Distribution by Age & Gender

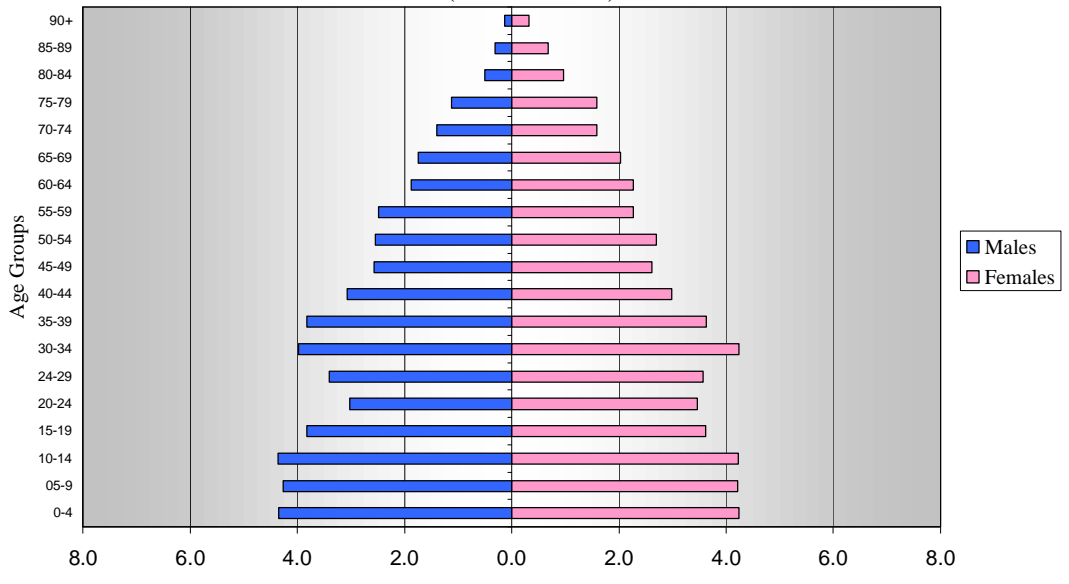
Canton % Population Distribution by Age & Gender

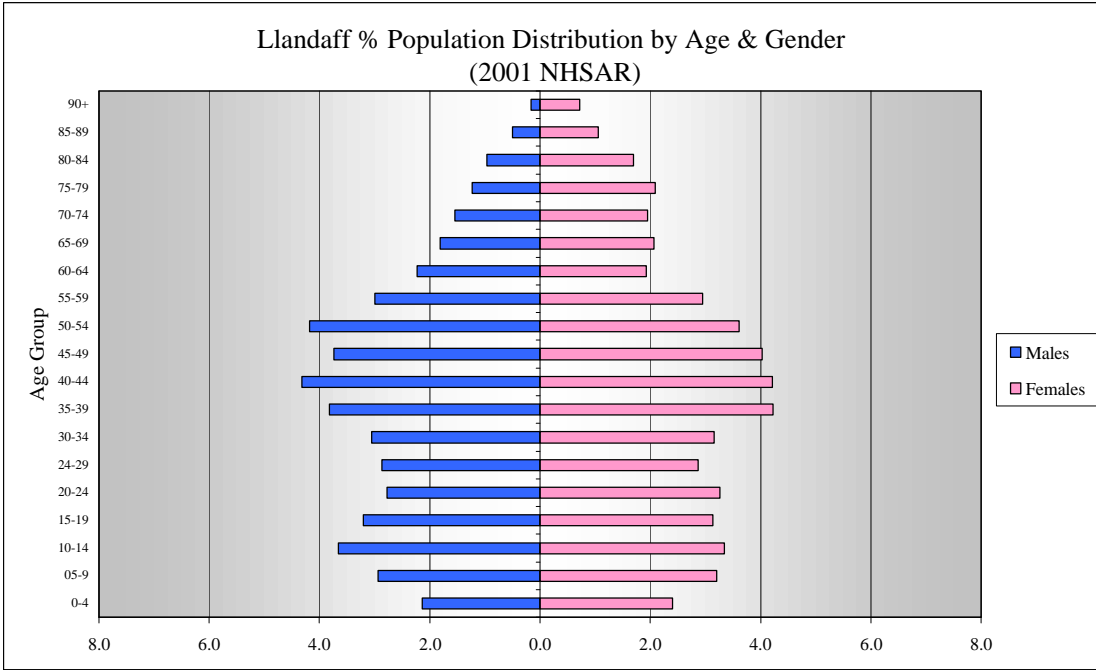
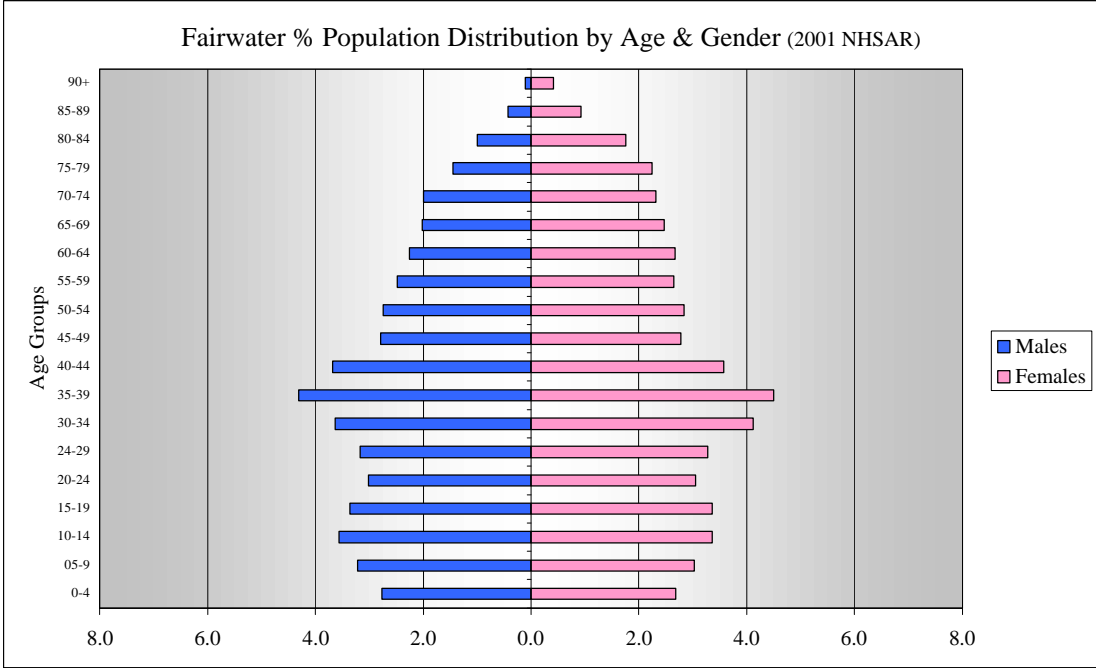


Creigiau/St Fagans Population Distribution by Age and Gender

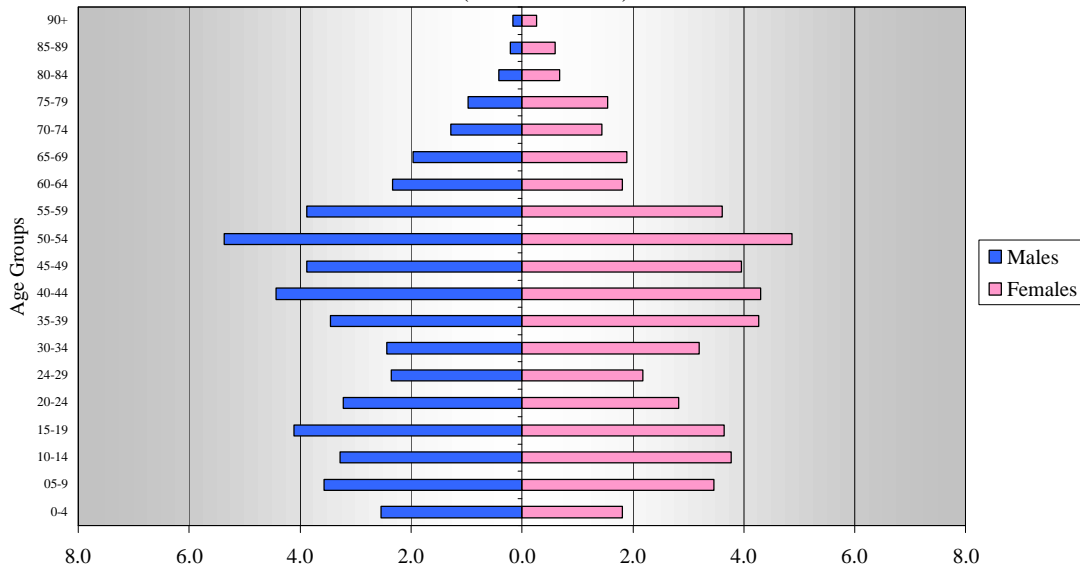


Ely Population Distribution by Age & Gender

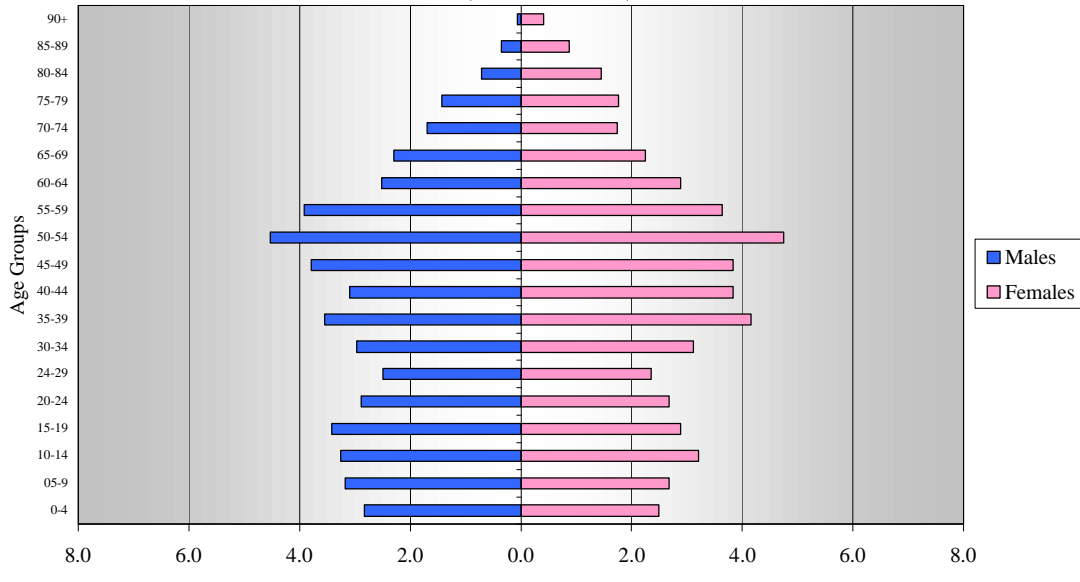




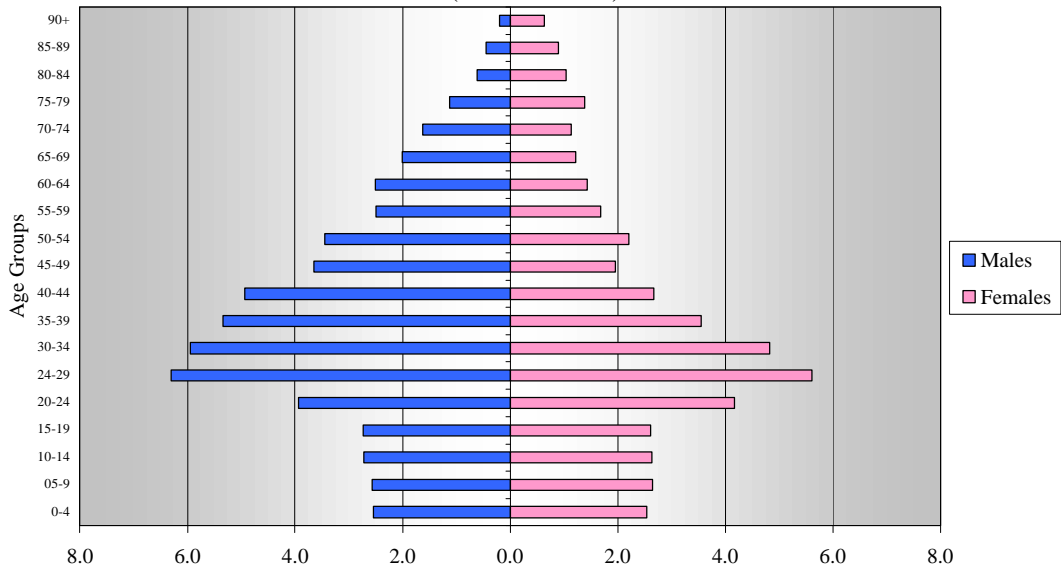
Pentyrch % Population Distribution by Age & Gender

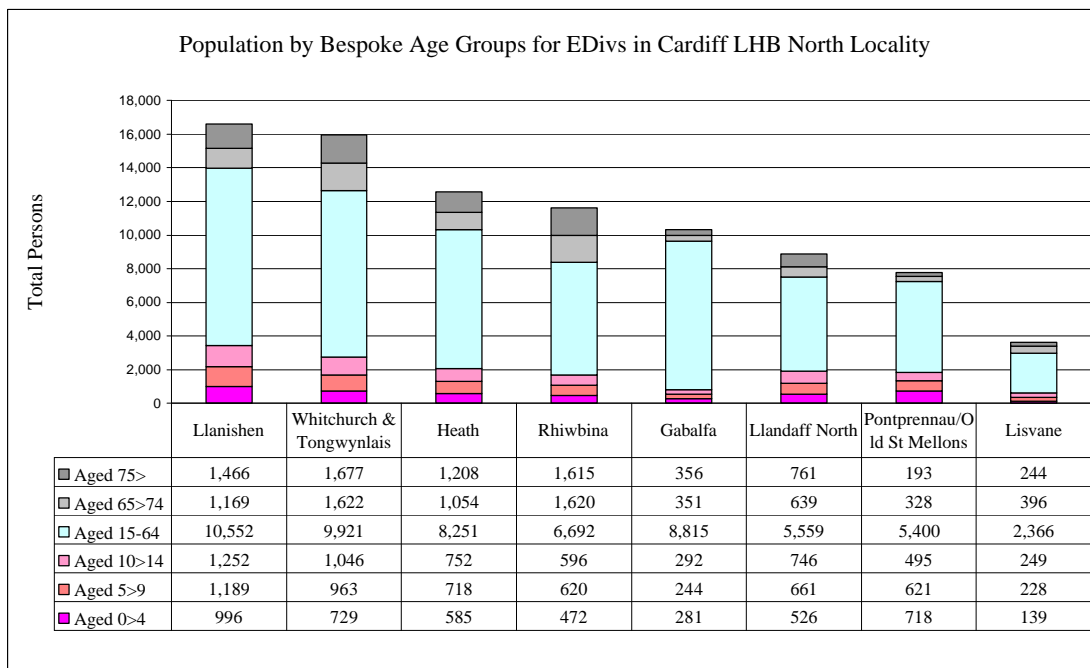
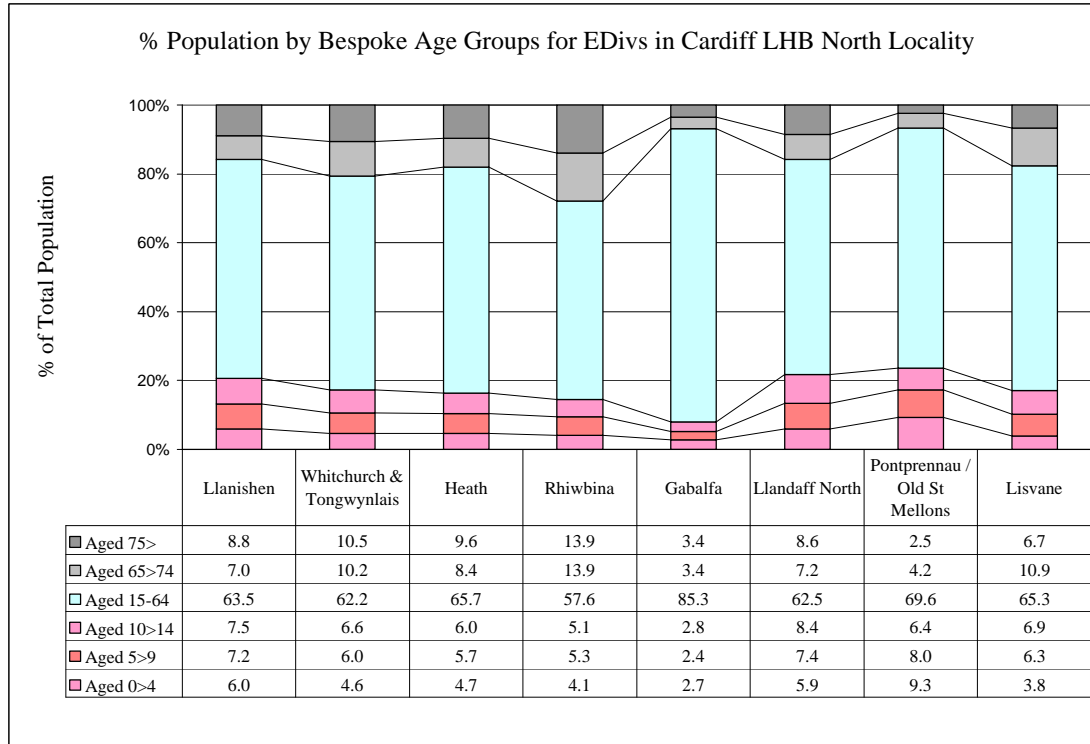


Riverside % Population Distribution by Age & Gender

Which North Locality EDivs Have the Highest Proportion of Children & Elderly Residents?

Pontprennau / Old St Mellons contains the highest proportion of child residents for any EDiv not just in the North locality but across the whole of Cardiff LHB.



Population Dependency Ratios in the North Locality show the greatest variance of any locality area in the LHB. Rhiwbina has the highest ratio in all of Cardiff at 0.74 due largely to its population aged 65

plus, while Gabalfa has one of the lowest at 0.17, due largely to its resident student population of approximately 3,000 persons aged 18 to 30.

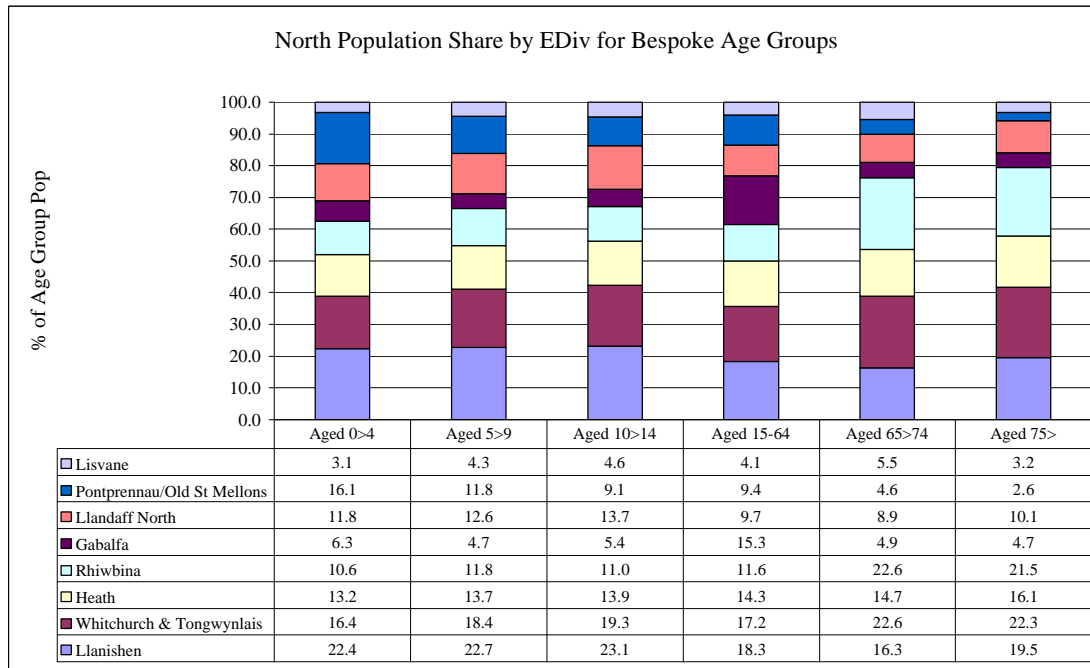

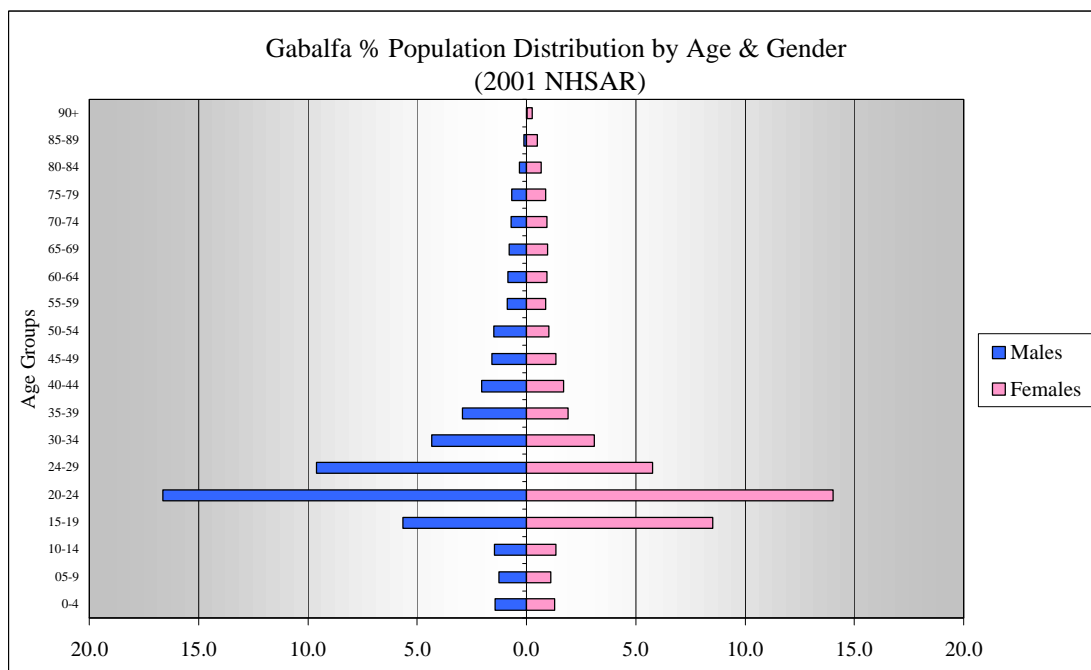
Which EDivs Have the Highest Proportion of North Cardiff's Children and Elderly Residents?



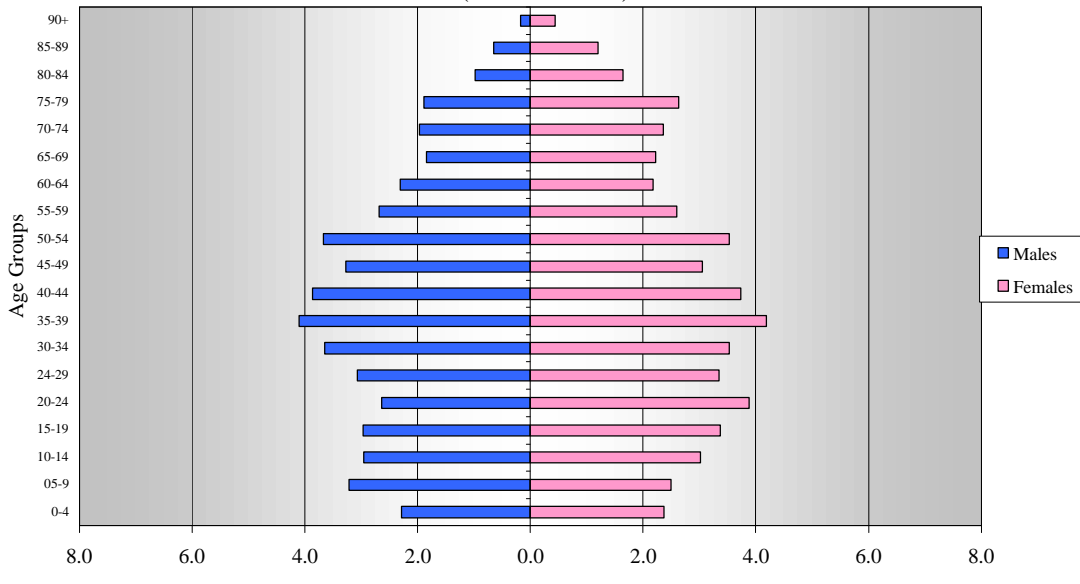

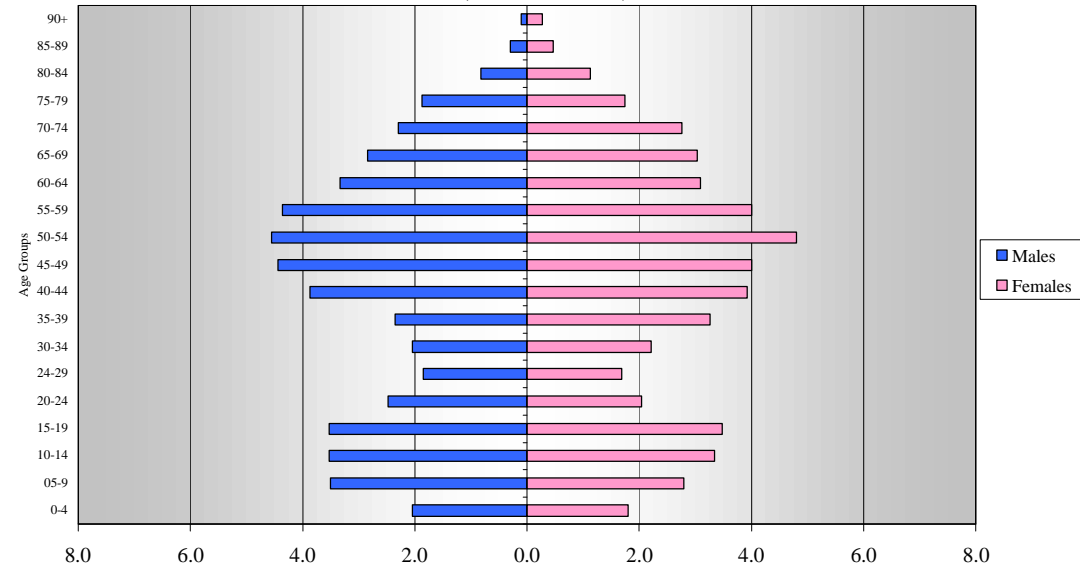
North Locality and Constituent Electoral Divisions Detailed % Population Distributions by Age and Gender



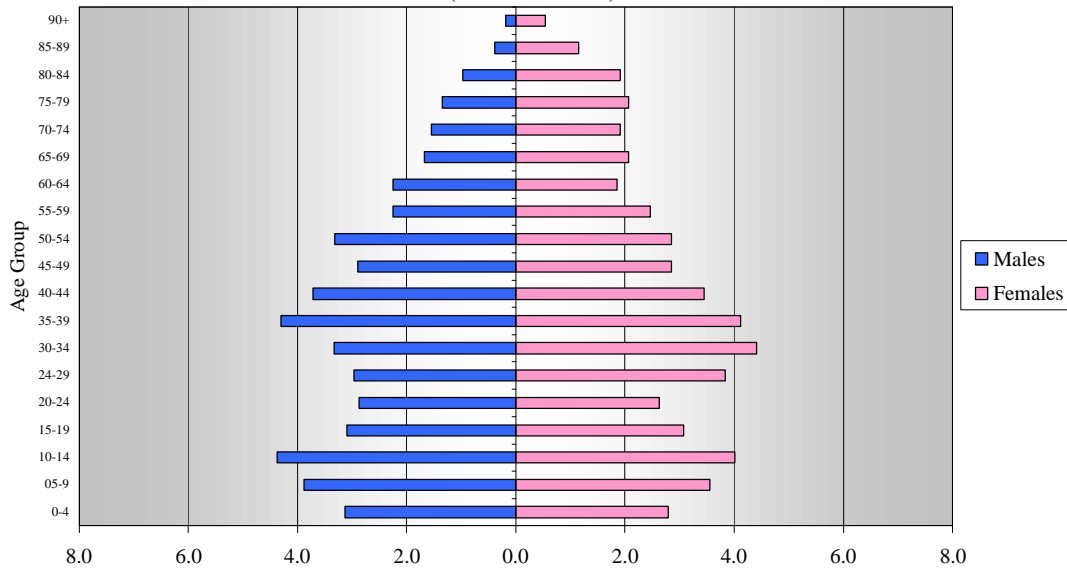
Heath % Population Distribution by Age & Gender

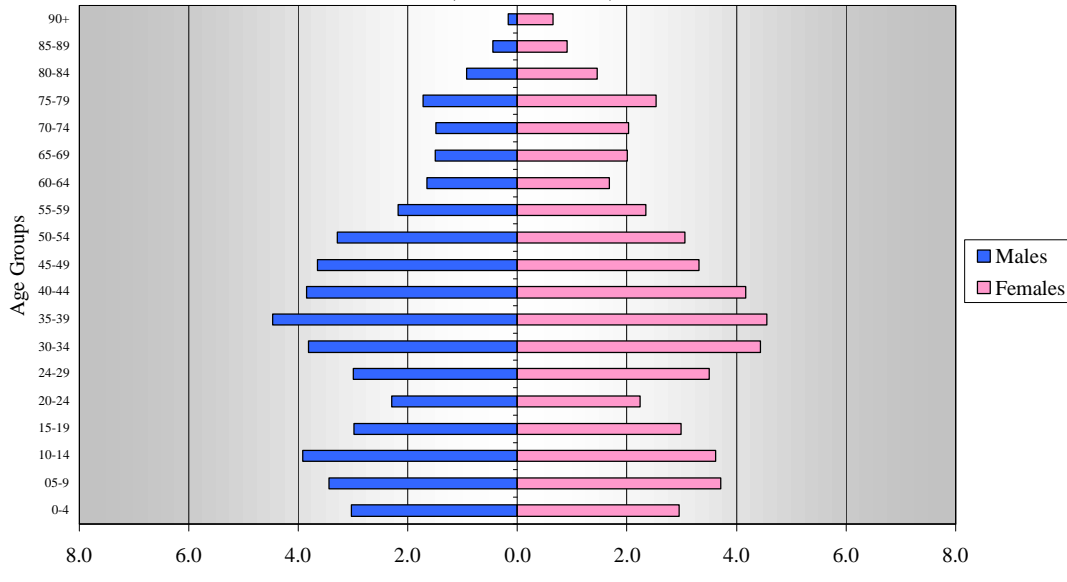
Lisvane % Population Distribution by Age & Gender

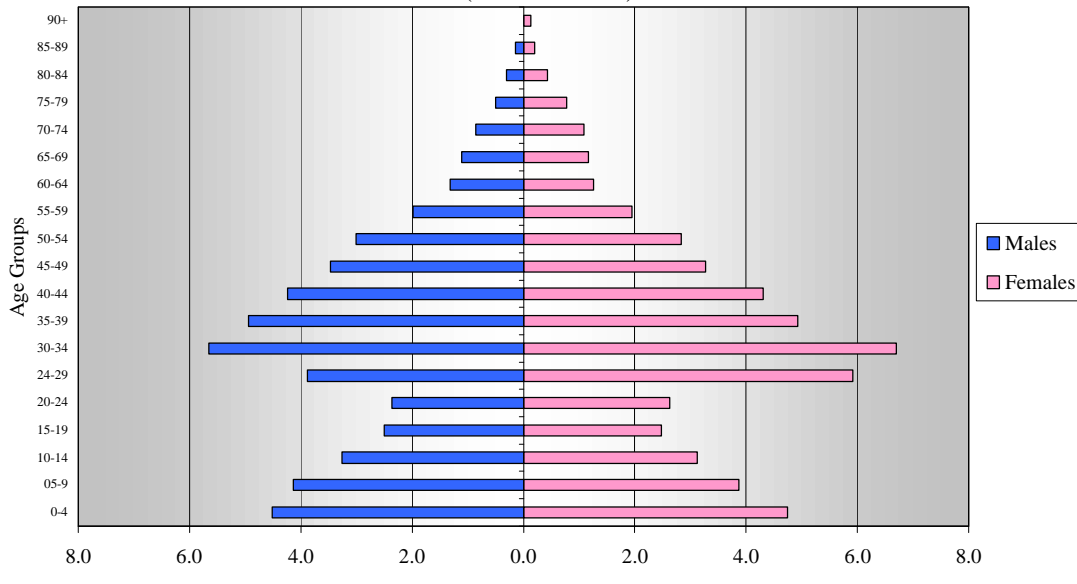
Llandaff North % Population Distribution by Age & Gender

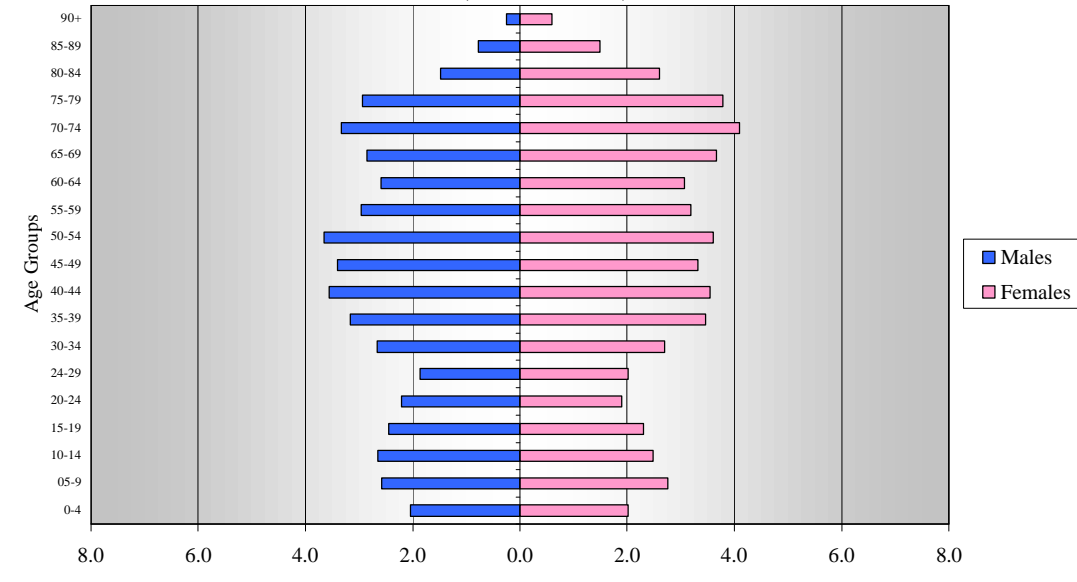
Llanishen % Population Distribution by Age & Gender
