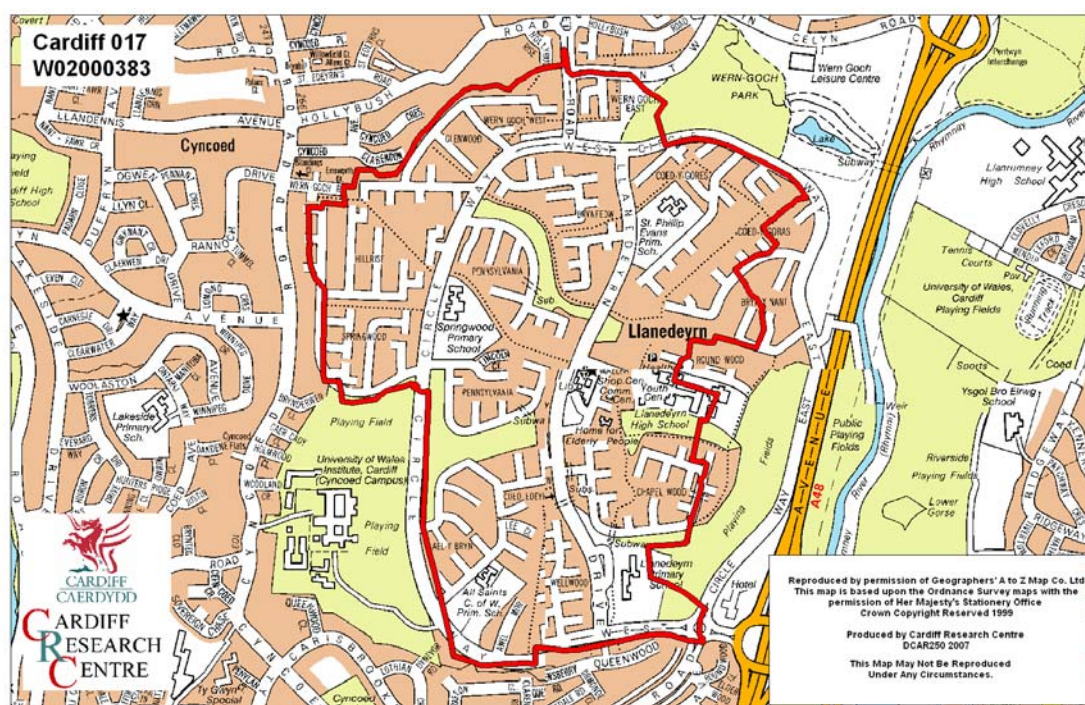


Llanedeyrn Middle Super Output Area

A comparison of Population Age Structure's for Mid 2004 from the National Statistics experimental Mid Year Estimate and the National Health Service Administrative Records (NHSAR)

Disclosure Control: Due to a requirement to observe the Registrar General's disclosure control protocols for experimental and official Mid Year Estimates of population it has been necessary to round population figures provided in this profile to the nearest 100 persons. Due to the danger of disclosure by difference the NHSAR population figures in this brief have also been rounded to the nearest 100 persons. For both datasets, when the population estimate was less than 50 persons, the value of 50 has been used. However, it is important to note that all graphics and the percentages presented in this profile have been produced using raw un-rounded estimates. The difference between NHSAR and MYE population estimates are also presented here in their un-rounded raw format.

Summary Key Statistics

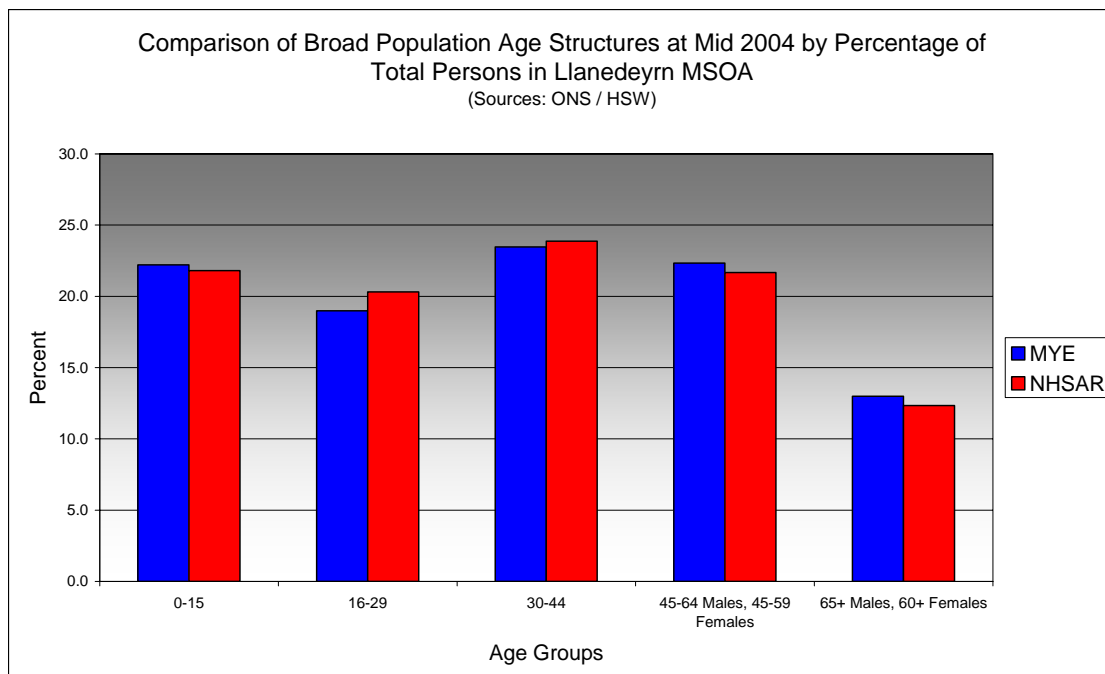
- In Llanedeyrn total NHSAR population at Mid 2004 was 14.6% (approximately 1,000 persons) higher than the experimental Mid Year Estimate.
- Total male NHSAR population was 18.4% higher, while total female population was 11.1% higher than the experimental Mid Year Estimate.
- NHSAR population counts showed the greatest variance from the Experimental MYEs in the following age groups: 85+ years 48.8% higher (difference of just 20 persons) and those aged 25 to 29 years 31.0% higher.
- Llanedeyrn is ranked 35th (MYE) and 33rd (NHSAR) out of 47 MSOAs in Cardiff for it's total dependency ratio.
- Within the Cardiff Central Locality Llanedeyrn is ranked 4th (MYE & NHSAR) out of 11 MSOAs for it's total dependency ratio.
- Llanedeyrn is ranked 10th (MYE) and 6th (NHSAR) out of 47 MSOAs in Cardiff for the total number of younger dependents aged 0 to 14.
- Within it's locality Llanedeyrn is ranked 1st (MYE & NHSAR) out of 11 MSOAs for the total number of younger dependents aged 0 to 14.
- Llanedeyrn is ranked 39th (MYE) and 35th (NHSAR) out of 47 MSOAs for the total number of older dependents aged 65 plus.
- Within it's locality Llanedeyrn is ranked 7th (MYE & NHSAR) out of 11 MSOAs for the total number of older dependents aged 65 plus.
- The majority of dependent age groups (0 to 14 + 65 and over) are younger dependents aged 0 to 14, representing 67.5% (MYE) and 67.8% (NHSAR) of total dependents.

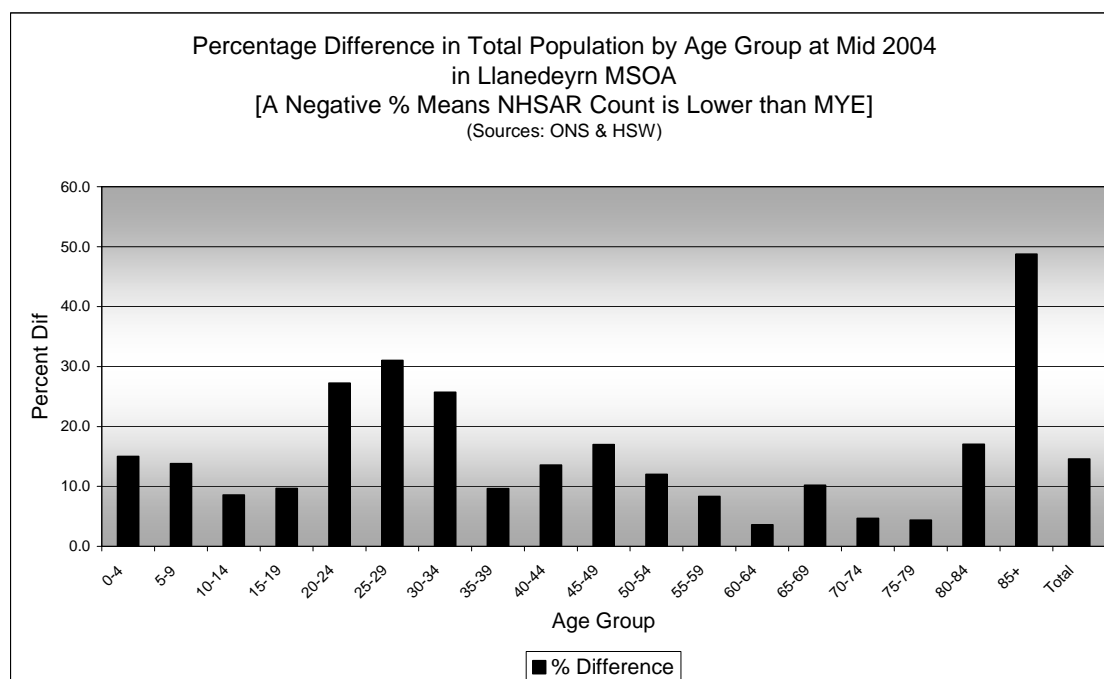

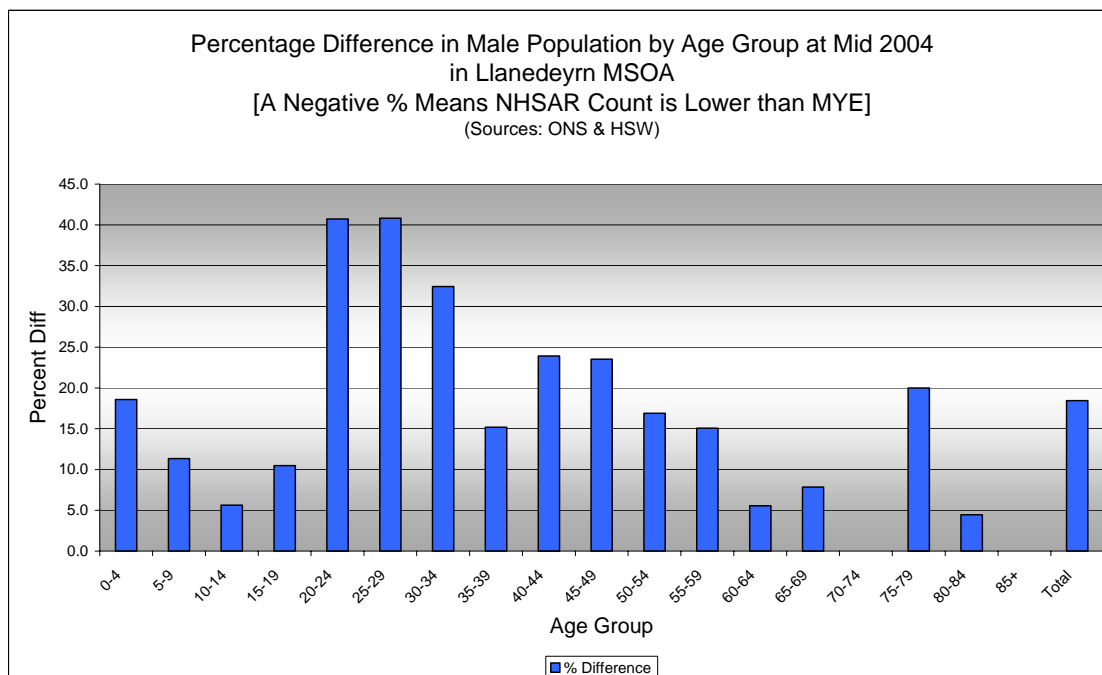


Quinary Age Group Comparisons – 2004 NHSAR Minus MYE

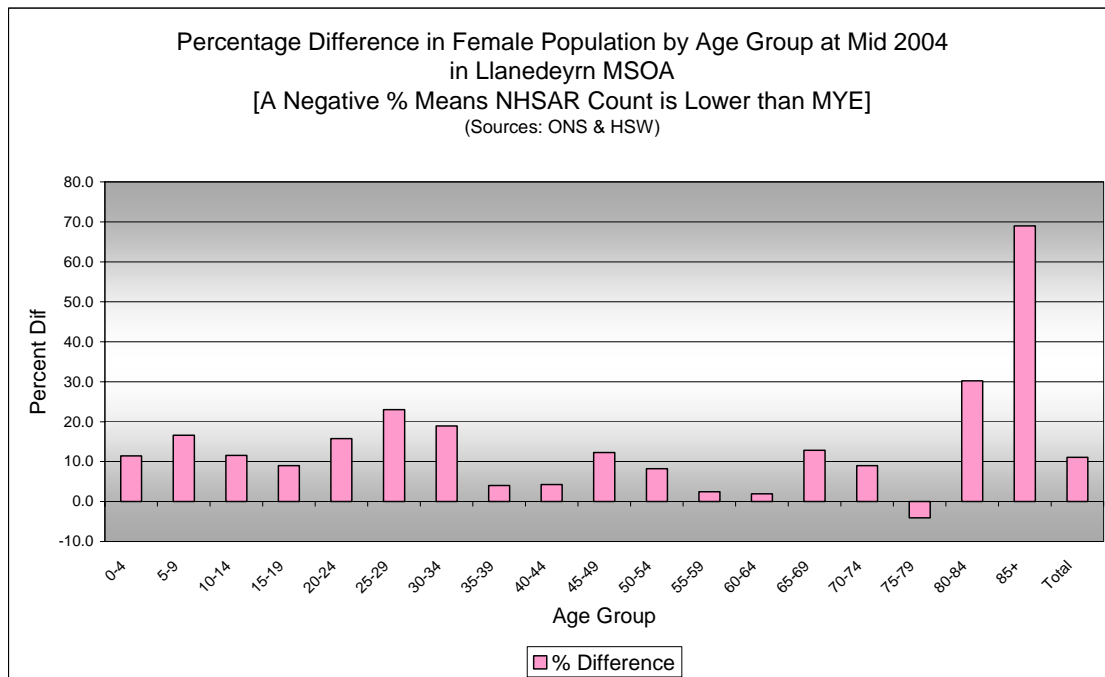

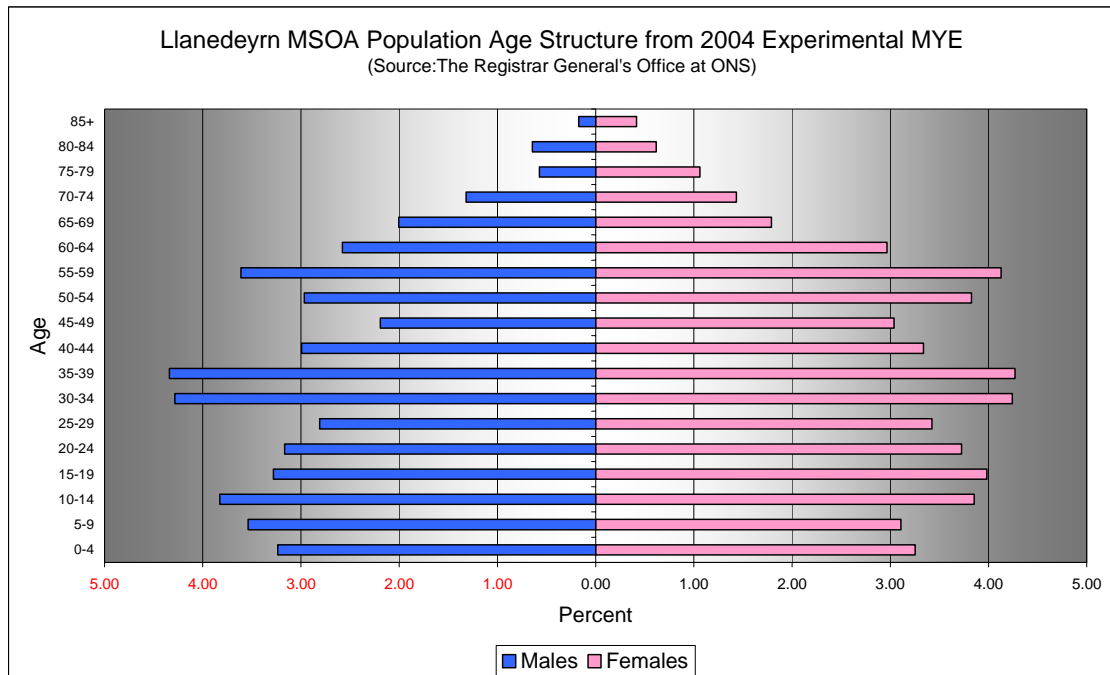

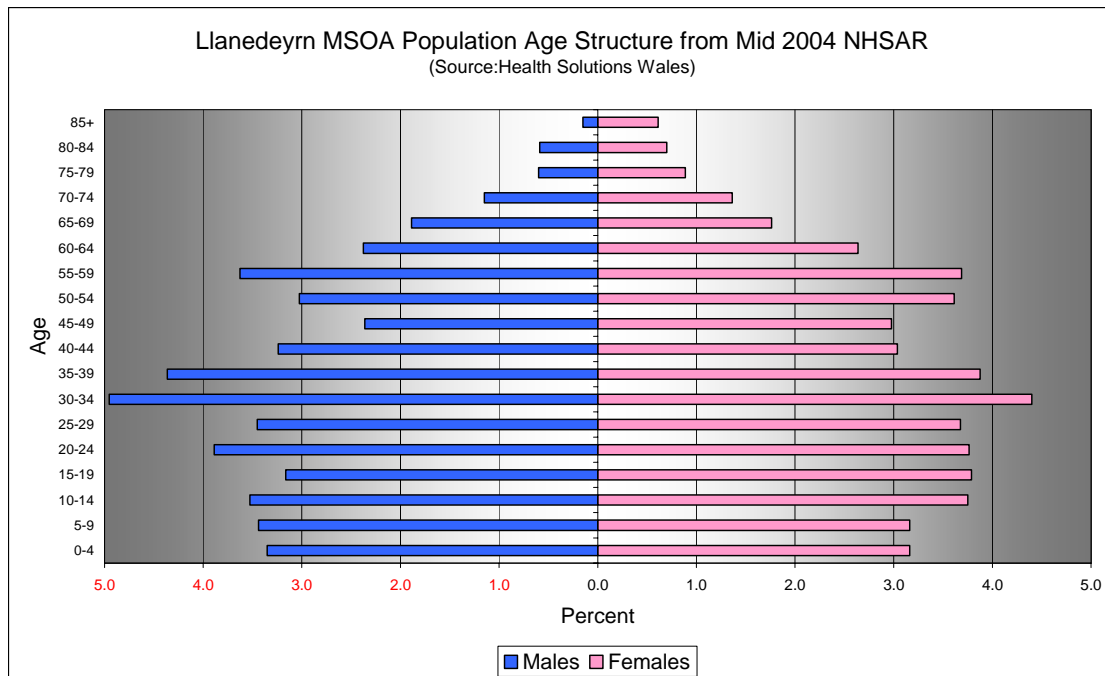
Quinary Population Age Structure - 2004 MYE
